Safety Tips for Parents and Students:

ENTRANCES, EXITS, AND PICK-UP/DROP-OFF LOCATIONS

Bus loading and unloading areas will be closed during drop-off and release times. Buses only traffic.

DSSTMS@GVR

- 1) DSST MS students will be dropped off by car in the West Parking Lot, along the sidewalk directly in front of Building 3,
- 2) DSST MS students will enter and exit from the Intermediate Academy vestibule (3-101).

DSST HS@GVR

- 1) Recommended Option: DSST HS students will have the option to be dropped off by car in the South parking lot next to the stadium (GVR Student parking)- QUICK DROP OFF to avoid long lines and wait times (See below)
- 2) DSST HS students will be dropped off by car in the West Parking Lot, along the sidewalk directly in front of Build. 2
- 3) DSST HS students will enter and exit from the Academy vestibule (2-101)(Building 1-Door number 9)
- 4) DSST HS students may park only in the parking lot next to the stadium with a student parking permit (the first three rows to the left south side) during school hours 8:00 AM 5:00 PM. Students will be able to park in visitor or staff/faculty parking spaces after 5:00 pm for extracurricular activities- Not overnight parking.

Each parent has a definite role in the safe and efficient operation of a school's transportation system.

If the transportation program, as a whole, is to function effectively, the parents must assume their responsibilities to the program and extend cooperation and support to the people charged with its operation.


We encourage parents to do the following:
