(Please read these prior to your attendance at the Arizona State Latin Convention. By attending the event, you agree to follow the rules below.)

Each student is expected to conduct his/her self in a mature and responsible manner during the Convention. This first person who is responsible for your conduct is yourself. Everyone is encouraged to have a good time and enjoy the experience, so we ask that you refrain from behavior that will present others around you from enjoying their time at the convention too!

Each delegation's sponsor(s)/chaperone(s) are primarily responsible for monitoring the conduct of their school and are asked to monitor the conduct of all student attendees in general.

The following are a list of rules and expectations that each convention attendee shall observe.

- Treat all fellow attendees, both students and adults, with respect, kindness, and dignity. Any instance of misconduct should be referred to the state chair.
- Conduct yourself and govern your actions with integrity.
- Use or possession by any convention attendee of alcohol, drugs, or mind-altering substances is illegal.
- Any illegal activity, including gambling (but not limited to), lotteries, betting activities for profit, or other activity in violation of local, state, or federal laws will be reported to the local authorities and the delegate's school officials.
- There shall be no smoking or vaping at the convention.
- Students will complete at their declared Latin level. Please refer to the "AZJCL Convention Booklet"
- General assembly is mandatory for all delegates.
- Only persons attending convention may participate in contests or convention activities.
- Name tags issued at the convention shall be worn visibly at all times. You will not be permitted to participate in a test or contest or other events without your nametag clearly visible. (Costume Contest competitors must have their tags with them and wear them when not being judged for the competition).
- Students having access to vehicles at the convention is strongly discouraged. Any student who drives his or her own car to Convention must have permission from the sponsor and parent. Students riding in a vehicle driven by a student must have written permission of the parent to ride in the specific vehicle. Sponsors are highly encouraged to collect car keys.
- Neat school clothes are appropriate attire for everyone. No attire should be revealing,

extremely form fitting, or in disrepair. No clothing should contain inflammatory, suggestive, racial, or other inappropriate writing, advertisement, or artwork.

- Eat only in designated areas.
- During testing, you shall not request assistance from any delegate, sponsor, or chaperone.
- By attending convention, you agree that your image will be posted on AZJCL's social media sites (Instagram and Facebook.)
- Delegates must be on campus the entire time.
- Failure to abide by these rules will result in being sent home at the expense of the child's parents/guardians.
