Grades-

- First quarter grades have been finalized and posted. You can find them under the grades tab on your infinite campus parent portal. Contact Emily Gannon (gannone@greenecountycsd.net) if you have forgotten your login information.

Monday Early Release and Activities-

- With the beginning of Winter season having started last week, we will allow in-season activities only to stay at school after early dismissal. Students who wish to stay must report to the cafeteria by 2:00 PM. Once checked in with our monitor, students will not be allowed to leave the cafeteria, Please note that any student who leaves the building will not be allowed back in until 3:45 PM. Currently only students who are on the 7th and 8th grade girls basketball and 7th and 8th grade wrestling rosters will be permitted to stay.
- Students who choose to leave must not return to the building until 3:45 as there will not be staff/coaches available to let them in and monitor them until that time due to professional development responsibilities. Students should not be entering through the business office side, they should be waiting to enter the front of the building when let in by coaches.

Dressing for the Cold Weather

- With the temperatures dropping, it's crucial that our students are dressed warmly to stay comfortable throughout the school day. We kindly request that your child comes to school wearing appropriate warm clothing such as jackets, hats, gloves, scarves, and boots if needed. This will help them stay comfortable during morning arrival time, recess and other outdoor activities. We will allow students outside during morning arrival time unless the "feels like" temperature is below 10 degrees. I will use The Weather Channel app to make this determination.

Food Bank of Iowa-

GCCSD partners with the Food Bank of Iowa to provide food products for our students and families.
Food pantry items are sent home in student backpacks on Fridays. We strive to provide items to create a meal and/or supplement the home's pantry. All students are eligible to receive pantry items.

Communication-

As we continue to build strong partnerships between home and school, we want to remind everyone about the communication process for any questions or concerns:

Arrival

For the safety of all, students should not arrive at school before **7:45 a.m.**, as we do not have staff available for supervision before this time.

Once students arrive at 7:45, they have the following options:

- Free breakfast is available for all students in the cafeteria.
- Students may go to the **auditorium** or **outside** to wait for the school day to begin.
 - Please note: No food or drinks are allowed in the auditorium. We appreciate your attention to these guidelines to ensure a safe and smooth start to each school day.

Attendance-

- Attendance is a priority at GCMS. The only way students can learn is if they are at school each and every day. A building goal for this year is that 90% of students will be in attendance at least 90% of school days for the 24-25 school year. Please make sure that you are encouraging your student to be in attendance and communicating with the office when they do need to be out for illness. Automated attendance letters do go out when your student has missed 3,6, & 9 days.
