Abstract. The maximum length of the abstract is 500 words, one paragraph. Written in Times New Roman 10 font. 1 (single) space. Abstract using English and contains the essence of the introduction, literature review, methods, results and discussion, conclusions.

Keywords: One until six words

(Consists of a minimum of 3 keywords and a maximum of 6 keywords, each keyword separated by a semicolon. (;), (Times New Roman 10 font with single spacing)

INTRODUCTION (Times New Roman 12 font with bold text)

Contains background, topic, scope, purpose and literature review (Times New Roman 11 font, single spacing). Each paragraph is written 12 mm from the left edge (first line indent 2). If there is a direct quote, it is written indented from the left edge of 12 mm. the proportion contains 15-20% or 1.5 to 2 pages. (Times New Roman 11 font, single spacing).

Can be written in several subchapters. If written in several sub-chapters, the writing uses numerical numbering.

Each paragraph is written 12 mm from the left edge (first line indent 2). If there is a direct quote, it is written indented from the left edge of 12 mm. the proportion contains 5-10% or 0.5 to 1 page. (Times New Roman 11 font, single spacing).

Can be written in several subchapters. If written in several sub-chapters, the writing uses numerical numbering.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION (Times New Roman 11 font, bold)

Presents an argument that contains research findings or results, reinforced with relevant data and information (Times New Roman 11 font, single spacing). Each paragraph is written 12 mm from the left edge (first line indent 2). If there is a direct quote, it is written indented from the left edge of 12 mm. the proportion of content is 60-70% or 6 to 7 pages. (Times New Roman 11 font, single spacing). Can be written in several sub-chapters. If written in several sub-chapters, the writing uses numerical numbering

CONCLUSION (Times New Roman 11 font, bold)

The conclusion should contain recommendations and a summary of the research. The recommendations provided should correlate with the concepts of the research conducted or suggestions for improving the research. The summary must have examples of answers that are in accordance with the research objectives or findings obtained. (The summary should not contain repetition of the results and discussion.) The proportion contains 5-10% or 0.5 to 1 page. (Times New Roman 11 font, single spacing). Each paragraph is written 12.5 mm from the left edge (first line indent 2).

ACKNOWLEDGMENTS (If any acknowledgments) (Times New Roman 12 font, bold)

Addressed to all persons or parties involved or assisting in the completion of the research activities (Times New Roman 11 font, single spacing).

REFERENCES (Times New Roman 11 font, bold)

All references used in the manuscript must be listed in this section. In this section, all references used must be taken from primary sources (scientific journals and/or sources in the form of books) published in the last 10 (ten) years. At least each manuscript must have 15 (fifteen) references and it is

recommended to use the reference tool - Mendeley referring to the APA 7th edition standard (Times New Roman 11 font, single space).
