You submit:

- Personal details
- Academic record
- Activities
- Essays

Step 2: Shortlisting

Based on:

- Profile strength
- Written responses
- Overall potential

Step 3: Assessment

Includes:

- Written tests
- Logical thinking
- English ability

Step 4: Group Activities

You are evaluated on:

- Teamwork
- Communication

- Behavior

Step 5: Interview

You are assessed on:

- Thinking
- Personality
- Clarity
- Motivation

Step 6: Final Selection

- Selected students are nominated
 - Placement assigned globally
 - Financial support confirmed

Step 2: Focus on Community Work

You must show impact.

Examples:

- Teaching
- Volunteering
- Helping communities

This is a major selection factor.

Step 3: Show Initiative

Do not wait for opportunities.

Create them:

- Identify problems
- Take action
- Stay consistent

Step 4: Build a Strong Personal Story

You must clearly explain:

- Your background
- What you experienced
- What you did
- What you want to do

Everything in your application must connect.

Step 5: Write Strong Essays

Use this structure:

Experience
Reflection
Action
Future

Avoid generic answers.

Step 6: Master Communication

You must:

- Speak clearly
- Explain ideas
- Show confidence

Simple communication is enough.

Step 7: Perform in Group Activities

You must:

- Listen
- Contribute
- Respect others
- Help the team

Do not dominate.

Step 8: Prepare for Interviews

You must:

- Answer clearly
 - Think logically
 - Stay composed
 - Be genuine
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10. Preparation Timeline (What to Do Before Applying)

6–12 Months Before

- Strengthen academics
- Start 1–2 strong activities
- Begin community work
- Practice communication

3–6 Months Before

- Build consistency
- Track your work
- Reflect on experiences

1–3 Months Before

- Prepare application responses
- Practice interviews

- Organize documents
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11. Common Mistakes

- Only focusing on grades
 - Fake or last-minute activities
 - Collecting random certificates
 - Generic essays
 - Weak communication
