Schedule

Practices:

- Practices will likely begin the week of Aug 12th
- o All teams will practice two nights a week Mon-Fri
 - 90 min to 2 hrs, 5-9pm
- Practices will be at local Mukwonago schools with occasional practices at SW facility in Waukesha when there are conflicts.

Tryouts

- 5th grade Wed May 29th MHS West Gym 5:30-6:30pm
- 6th grade Tues May 28th Rolling Hills 6:30-8:00pm
- 7th grade Mon May 20th Rolling Hills 6:30-8:00pm
- 8th grade Wed May 29th MHS West Gym 7:00-9:00pm
- Each grade will have 2 teams with 10 players. *There may be exceptions to this.
 - Again this year we will not be cutting off registrations at a certain number. Every player is invited to tryout and we will select 10 players for each team through the tryout process. We want everyone to have an opportunity to play volleyball and not have it be based on who registers first.
 - Club directors and outside evaluators will be selecting the teams.
 - o 6th, 7th and 8th grade will be divided into A and B teams
 - 5th grade will be split into "equal" teams. We will offer 1 "friend request" to be on the same team. No guarantees.
 - If we have enough players at any age level for 3 teams (and can find coaches) we may field 3 teams - A, B, C (with exception of 6th grade possibly being A/B/B)
 - Again this year we would like to keep all 5th and 6th graders and not cut any players. This will depend on having enough coaches and tryout numbers so there may be more than 10 players on a team.
 - Not attending tryouts may result in not being placed on a team for 7th-8th graders. Players not at tryouts cannot make the A team. (if you cannot attend tryouts, please reach out to us).
 - Team selections will not be announced until after all tryouts are complete. We will post rosters on our website.
- Expectation is if you try out and make a team, you will commit to that team.
 We want kids that want to play regardless of what team they make.

2024 Fees & Forms

• \$260 - no increase this year

- covers gym time, league fees, coach expenses, equipment, insurance, uniform top each year
- No fundraising currently being done
- 2024 tryout fee \$10 helps cover gym cost and tryout tees refundable up until April 21st after that no refunds
- All participants must complete the required forms <u>prior to tryouts</u>. If you
 played last year or filled these out for camps you do not need new ones for
 tryouts. All players will need 2024 forms prior to first practice in Aug (link
 to electronic forms on our website). Insurance runs Sept-Sept.

Registration

- New this year! Registration will be done completely on TeamSnap!
- 5th and 6th grade will require all dues paid prior to tryouts since no players will be cut.
- 7th and 8th graders must pay a tryout fee at time of registration then go back and finish registration and pay dues after making a team. There will be a deadline set for this.
 - o Registration dues are non-refundable.

Requirements

- Black shorts for games (spandex preferred)
- Knee pads (recommend white)
- Athletic shoes (preferred tied)
- Recommend having a ball at home for practicing

Coaches

- Each team will have 2 coaches
- Trying to have at least 1 experienced coach at each level
- Coaches pass background checks and ASP training
- Coaches clinic run by Juniors

Playing time

- No set quotas on playing time. However, we encourage coaches to make sure every player feels they are contributing.
- 5th and 6th grade should be close to equal

- Factors that play into playing time:
 - o Attendance at practice
 - Effort and attitude at practice
 - Willingness to learn and be coached

\Box	Level of play - there will be kids at each grade that are inexperienced - ever
	if your daughter didn't play before, she could develop faster than another
	player who did. There will be all levels of experience and skill at each
	grade's tryouts.
	Conflicts with other sports/activities - we ask for known conflicts on the
	registration and after team selections. We try our best to schedule
	practices around conflicts but can't guarantee it. There are no club rules
	about playing other sports but the more a player misses, the less they
	develop. We would just ask that you make every effort to attend vb, even
	for a portion of the time.
	What we look for at tryouts - evaluators will rate each player multiple times
	on each skill (mostly passing and serving for younger grades). They also look

for things like aggressiveness, attitude, body language, communication, athleticism and volleyball potential.
