Matthew 6:19-21 New International Version ¹⁹ “Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. ²⁰ But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. ²¹ For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

What is a treasure?

A treasure is something valuable.

For many people, earthly possessions are very important. They work all their lives to raise money. Many people work so hard to get rich that they neglect family. Sometimes people work so hard to gather treasures that they forget about the Lord.

How can we gather heavenly treasures?

Hulle was egter verkeerd. Toe hulle grafkelders jare na hulle dood oopgemaak is, was hulle skatte nog steeds daar. In sommige gevalle kon 'n mens sien dat rowers die skatte gesteel het.

Jesus sê vir ons daar waar jou skat is daar is jou hart ook. As aardse skatte vir jou belangrik is, sal hemelse skatte nie vir jou belangrik wees nie. Ons het hemelse skatte nodig om eendag saam met Jesus in die hemel te kan wees. Aardse skatte kan jou nie in die hemel bring nie.



Wat neem jy met jou saam as jy doodgaan? Kan jy jou huis saam neem? Kan jy jou geld saamneem? Al wat jy met jou kan saamneem is ander mense wat jy na Jesus toe gelei het.

Hoe kan ons hemelse skatte bymekaar maak?

Dit is belangrik om tyd saam met Jesus te spandeer. Dit is belangrik om elke dag die Bybel te lees en te bid.

Ons moet ook ons naaste help waar ons kan. Jesus wil hê dat ons moet omgee vir ons naaste.

Ons moet ander mense vertel van Jesus. Ons moes vir mense vertel dat Jesus vir ons sondes gesterf het en dat ons slegs deur Jesus in die hemel kan kom.
