Pay \$75 family membership fee via membership page (there is scholarship info if unable to pay).
Attend selection day and interview for a full day of programming TBA at the TBA . (Backup storm date: Feb 3rd)

Notification of acceptance will be sent out at the end of January.

RESPONSIBILITIES IF SELECTED:

- 1. Attend Local Training see Leadership Training Contract for details.
- 2. Attend Maine Mini Camp (MMC) at the end of April 2025 TBA.
- 3. The program cost is **\$TBA**, not including travel fees.
- 4. If the applicant decides to accept, a nonrefundable deposit of \$500 is due 2/12/25, in order to secure the delegate's spot. The remaining balance is due 5/5/25. If the program is canceled or if you have to cancel prior to 5/5/25, all but \$200 will be refunded. If you cancel after 5/5/25, the payment will not be reimbursed unless a new delegate is found as a replacement.
- 5. Support all other costs of preparation such as spending money and emergency money (to be returned if not used) and other preparation costs.
- 6. Fill out all appropriate health and legal forms on MyCISV and submit your passport information for the travel coordinator.
- 7. Reflect and share your experience with the greater CISV Maine community, including presenting about your experience at the 2025 Fall Annual Meeting and Showcase (beginning of Nov. 2025).
