Introduction should describe background of the research, the solutions offered and any comparable related works. if in the script there is a quote, use [1], [2] and so on by using citation tools Mendeley or Endnote on IEEE format. The term in a foreign language is written italic (italic).

It is recommended for the Author to use following paper structure: **Introduction - Methods - Result and Discussion - Conclusion**. Any additional sections are allowed between Introduction and Methods, especially for paper with high originality such as proposing new algorithm or methods.
