¹ Please see below for various notations and guidance on the action:

- a. Everyone plays all games (win, lose, or draw).
- b. Arrive 30 minutes before your first round
- c. You do not need to check-in before the event.
- d. Reminder: No outside food is allowed
- e. Schedule:
 - i. Quads: Time Control: G/25 d5², 3 Round Games
 - Please plan your day based on the schedule below: ii.
 - Quads @ 12pm~2.30pm (arrive by 11:45am): 3 rounds (games)
 - iii. Notation during the game is not mandatory, but recommended.
- f. Prepare to keep this document handy, physically and/or electronically, throughout the game day.
- g. Please pack to bring:³
 - Writing instruments to record your games. (Optional for kids).
 - ii. A chess clock if you have one
 - Come as you are if you don't have a chess clock.
 - Chess clocks are required if either or both players have a chess clock.
 - Chess clocks will be on sale at the Help Desk
 - The tournament directors may place a chess clock on any games that are not progressing on schedule.

1. Before every game

- a. Check your pairings & results.
- b. Spectators will be asked to leave the playing room once the round is ready to begin.
- c. Inform the player where you will meet them when they finish their game.
- d. Please check your results after/before every round; if there are any errors, report them using BayAreaChess.com/changeform

2. After the tournament starts:

- a. Take care of any fees that you owe.⁴
- b. If you are interested in improving your chess or establishing a chess program at your school, please email enrich@bayareachess.com.

3. After the tournament ends:

- a. We will certify and submit to USCF shortly after each event.
- b. We will also share the results at BayAreaChess.com/results
- c. Please register for future tournaments (see <u>Tournament Calendar</u>⁵).

² Each player gets 25 minutes per game and there is a delay of 5 seconds for every move before the clock starts running.

³ Note: We will provide chess sets (pieces and boards) but you may bring your own to play or analyze outside the tournament playing area.
