1. Bisque fire tomorrow. Anything that was on the greenware shelf Sunday that did not make it into the kiln will likely get fired Friday or Saturday.
2. Next glaze fire will be Wednesday (shelf cut-off is Sunday evening). Anything on the shelf Sunday that does not make it into the kiln will likely get fired Friday or Saturday. We will continually strive to get everything fired in a timely

	manner. However, the logistics of loading a kiln can be complicated due to several variables; the quantity and size of projects, the length of time to load (up to 3 hours) and unload (1-2 hours), and the manpower to load/unload. There may be times when our firing goals are not met, but we will always do our best. 3. More members are requesting additional storage space. Since our space is very limited, we are discontinuing the “community storage” shelf and will begin offering extra storage space at a measured rate, giving all members equal access to additional storage. Please text Jamie if you are interested in renting additional space. Size and rate to be determined this week. Members using extra space for reclaim buckets (as opposed to requesting clay exchange) may continue at no fee.
SUN 11/10	1. More bisque is showing up in the reclaim. Please be sure to only put unfired clay in reclaim tubs and buckets. It is possibly coming from the Community Studio and/or the Member’s Studio. All Students, members, and interns are being reminded. 2. Membership is at its highest, so storage and work space is at a minimum. -Please be mindful of how much work space you are using and ensure that we have room at the table for several members at any given time. -Please limit your work and supplies to your personal storage shelf. FIRING SCHEDULE In the Member's Studio, we fire Wednesdays (sometimes sooner- Mon or Tues), and if we have an overload of pots, we'll fire again Friday or Saturday. We typically alternate between bisque and glaze fires. We do our best to get everyone's work fired in the order that they were glazed. However, due to the logistics of shapes and sizes, some items may get fired before others. Additionally, we will (on occasion) ensure that a certain item gets fired by a certain date at members' request (gift deadline, for example). The Community Studio kiln gets fired every 2-3 days, so we often squeeze in smaller pots made by members.

Therefore, we are implementing the following policies to ensure that all members have a clean and comfortable space to work: -Please do not leave your work at the handbuilding table unattended for longer than 15 minutes. -Please do not leave your work unattended at the handbuilding table during your wheel reservation unless you are using both areas simultaneously for a combined wheel/handbuilding project. -Please do not leave your work at the glaze table unattended longer than 5 minutes. CLEANING Please remember to use a clean sponge and mop, and <u><i>rinse often</i></u>. Otherwise, the clay spreads rather than being removed. Double check before leaving the room. Thank you for all of your effort to keep our studio clean, healthy, comfortable, and safe!

In an effort to reduce glazes from running and sticking to kiln cookies, we will begin thinning and testing select glazes so that their specific gravity measures slightly lower than the manufacturer's recommendation. These glazes will be clearly labeled so members are aware of changes. 2. We will provide a poster of tips for best glazing results. These tips include the following: Mix glaze well (individual electric mixing paddles coming soon for each bucket) Quick dip = best dip! 1 second = light coat 2 seconds = medium coat 3 seconds MAX (anything longer will be too thick) Shake excess glaze back into the bucket If dipping a second coat, limit dipping time and keep outside coverage on the top third of the pot <i>Thicker glaze application runs, drips, sticks to cookies, and also creates heavier pots</i> 3. The following bullet points from #7 of our Membership Agreement for Cleanliness & Studio Maintenance are being followed by most, <i>but not all members</i>. Please review and ensure that you are leaving the studio <u>better than you found it</u>. ● Wash hands before leaving the studio. Do not allow clay or dust to leave the room. ● All work areas, tools, wheels, and equipment must be cleaned after use. This includes sinks, floors, glaze buckets & benches, glaze table, tongs, scrapers, sponges, bats, etc. ● Clean the floor area around your work space and leave it better than you found it. ● All members will contribute to and keep record of studio clean-up jobs on the “Before You Go” checklist, going above and beyond their personal usage during each visit to the studio. This may include: ○ Washing windows & sills ○ Washing doors and door handles ○ Cleaning the sinks, faucets, walls, and floor in sink area ○ Cleaning the glaze area: buckets, shelves, island, counter, floor, etc. ○ Wiping walls & baseboards ○ Cleaning the plexiglass at wheel station ○ Wiping tables	

	○ Mopping ○ Cleaning the clay-weighing station, trash can and chuck-it bucket ○ Anything else that needs cleaning Members who are not adhering to the agreement will be subject to review and potentially removed from membership.
