- 1) Portia the spider jumps 3 feet.
- She then jumps another 2 feet.
- She finally reaches where she wanted to go after another 4 feet.
- How far did Portia travel?
- 2) The spider has three pairs of eyes that can see movement all around her.
- Her other eyes focus on color and space.
- If Portia has eight eyes in total, how many focus on color and space?
- 3) After Portia spots the other spider, she studies the space for some time.
- Portia then spends seven minutes hunting the other spider.
- If Portia began feeding 12 minutes after she spotted the other spider, how long did Portia study the space?
- 4) The male Portia spider can achieve lengths as long as 7 millimeters.
- That's 14 millimeters smaller than some of the spider's food. How large can the spider's food be?
- 5) The other spider builds a web 24 inches longer than Portia's hunting thread.
- If Portia's hunting thread is 15 inches, how long is the other spider's web?
- 6) To get the other spider, Portia hits the web a number of times on the first day.
- On the second day, Portia hits the web 6 more times.
- Portia's eighth hit on the third day finally gets the spider.
- If it took 23 hits to get her prey, how many times did Portia hit the web on the first day?
