


Accessing Students' Information in LAUSD Student Portal

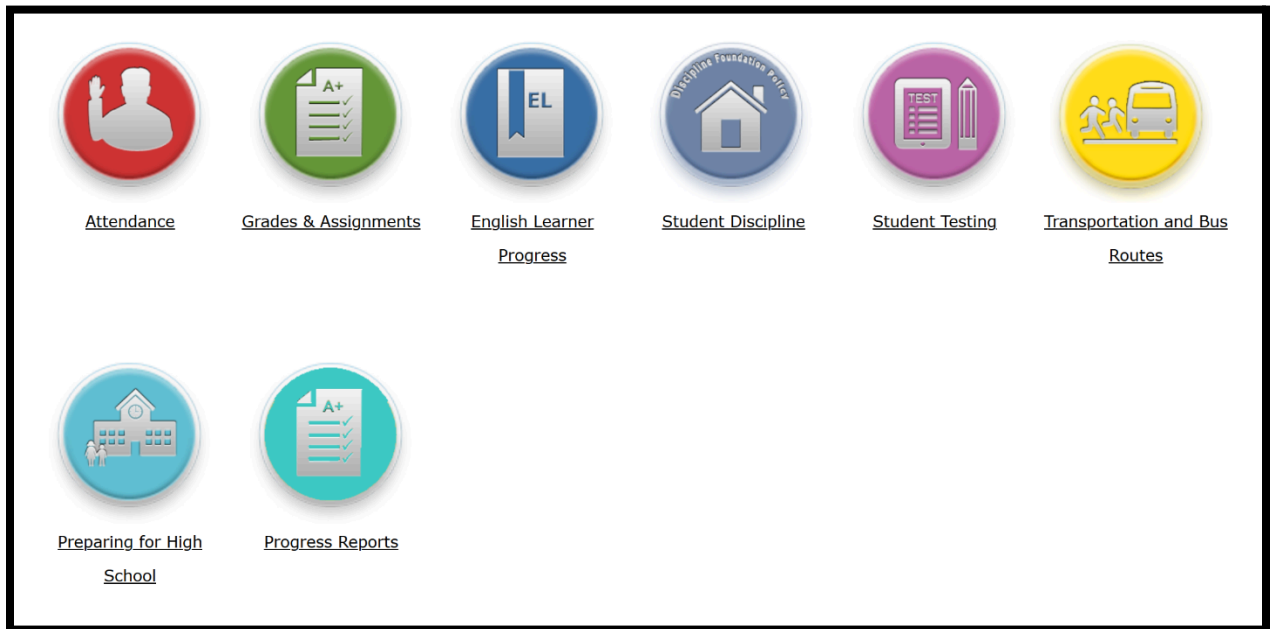
- 1) Search LAUSD Student Portal in a browser or click on <https://parentportalapp.lausd.net/parentaccess/studentLogin.jsp>

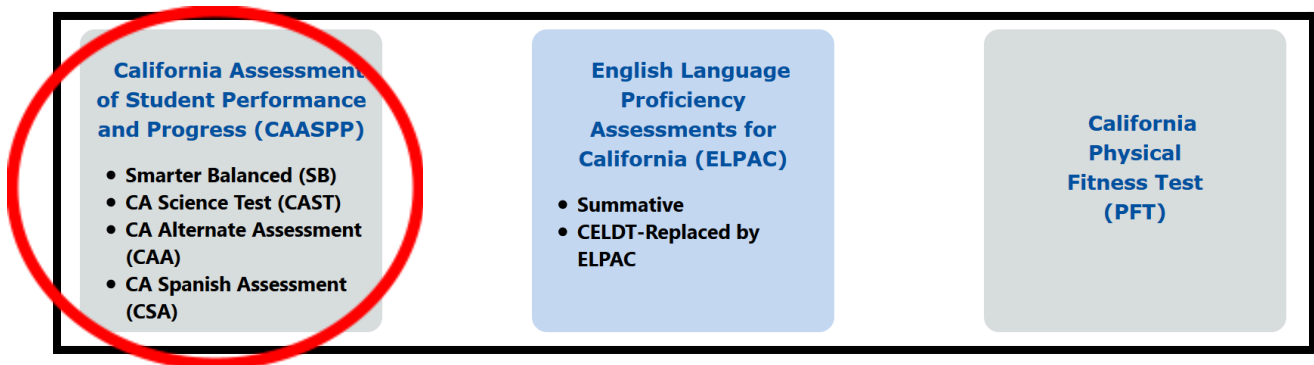
