Admin Update:

- Guest Presentation: Pexsisen Garden Plan by Matthew Kemshaw of Flourish School Food Society:
 - Looking to add elements where the grass is. Some ideas: a pathway, large perennial edible shrubs near the edges ex. raspberries, blueberries, honey berries as well as some apple trees growing to approx. 8ft tall and possibly some meadow habitat;
 - The result will create a green screen/wall;
 - This will create a true garden space and outdoor learning environment for the students;
 - Approval to go ahead with the idea and therefore a work party will be organized following Spring Break:
 - This will happen when the children are in school;
 - Matthew would coordinate with his staff and look for school community volunteers;
 - Students would do the planting and make some signs;
 - April 10th will likely be the community work party date.
 - Summer work experience program for high school students (grades 9-11);
 - Fundraising can be done to acquire supplies and to enhance the garden;
 - Consistent and ongoing support from Flourish School Food Society
- Admin Update: Moving to 21 Divisions next year - there will be 4 Kindergarten classes and close to 500 students;
