WHEN WILL ONLINE REGISTRATION BE AVAILABLE?

Registration will open at 9 a.m. on April 22.

HOW DOES THE REGISTRATION PROCESS WORK?

- 1. Parents/guardians will be able to register their student(s) using an online portal to provide the required information and documents. Families will need to have an account with the PowerSchool Enrollment Portal, and instructions will be mailed home. See PowerSchool details at https://www.dupage88.net/site/page/1649.
- 2. Fees will be paid electronically through a secure online payment service. Families will need to have an account with RevTrak, and instructions will be mailed home.

• Financial assistance/fee waivers for the 2024-25 school year will be shared soon.

The District 88 Board of Education requires a separate application for a waiver of school fees (<u>click here</u> for board policy on waiver of student fees). Therefore, a Fee Waiver Application must be completed. Note, if your child(ren) is/are DIRECTLY CERTIFIED through the National School Lunch Direct Certification process, student fees will automatically be waived. The application will be shared soon, or you may request it from the building contacts below. Note that full payment of instructional fees is expected and due by Sept. 1, unless a payment plan is established.

- Fees will be waived 100 percent for students with an <u>approved</u> Fee Waiver Application on file.
- Eligibility during one year does not guarantee future fee waiver eligibility; therefore, the Fee Waiver Application must be completed annually.

- Eligibility is effective on the date the application is received and approved. Any fees accumulated from past school years are still owed. If you need further information, contact:

RESIDENCY VERIFICATION FOR THE 2024-25 SCHOOL YEAR

District 88 will continue to implement its residency procedures to ensure the district can maximize its resources for families who reside within District 88 boundaries.

- 1. Proof of residency is required for all new students and whenever a change of address occurs. When a student is registering in District 88 for the first time, a parent/guardian must provide proof of identity and age by providing one of the following documents:
- Original or certified copy of birth certificate (which will be copied, and the original will be returned)
- Other records recognized by a court of law

The parent/guardian also must provide:

- Immunization records as required by state law
- The required physical examination signed by the student's physician
- Vision examination
- Dental examination
- 2. Residency verification is conducted on a yearly basis for all District 88 students.
- If you have received a letter from the district that your residency has been verified, you don't need to submit further documentation (unless you are a parent of an incoming freshman and have not submitted a copy of your child's birth certificate and parent ID).
- If you received a letter that further documentation is needed, please follow the instructions in that letter.
- If you have not received a letter from the district, please follow the instructions on the registration verification form below (select your preferred language from the list).
