Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Sketched Butterflies (163590); Sweetly Scripted (163600)
- **Card Stock:** Basic White (159276); Azure Afternoon (161719); Bright & Beautiful Designer Series 6x6 Paper (161449)
- **Stamp Pads:** Azure Afternoon (161663); Tuxedo Black Memento Ink (132708)
- **Tools:** Sketched Butterflies Dies (163491)
- **Miscellaneous:** Paper Trimmer (152392); Paper Snips Scissors (103579); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Stampin' Seal (152813); Mini Glue Dots (103683); Stampin Seal + (149699); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Stampin' Mini Dimensionals (144108); Stampin Blends Azure Afternoon (161672); Stampin Blends Basic Black (154843); Blending Brushes (153611)

Measurements:

- Azure Afternoon: 8 ½" x 5 ½"
- Bright & Beautiful Designer Series Paper: 3" x 5 ¼"
- Basic White: 2 ¾" x 5"; 4" x 5 ¼"

Instructions:

1. Cut a piece of Azure Afternoon Card Stock 8 ½" x 5 ½" and score at 4 ¼" then cut off 1" off one of the sides.
2. Cut a piece of Bright & Beautiful Designer Series Paper 3" x 5 ¼" and adhere to front of card base.
3. Cut a piece of Basic White 2 ¾" x 5" and stamp small butterflies in Tuxedo Black Memento.
4. Color small butterflies with the Light Azure Afternoon Stampin Blends.
5. Use the Blending Brushes and Azure Afternoon ink to add color to the Basic White Card Stock with the small butterflies.
6. Using the Azure Afternoon and Basic Black Stampin Blends flick ink onto the Basic White Card Stock from Step 4.
7. Adhere the Basic White Card Stock from steps 3-5 to the card front.
8. Stamp larger butterflies in Tuxedo Black Memento Ink. Then die cut with the Sketched Butterflies dies. Color the butterflies with Azure Afternoon light and dark Stampin Blends.
9. Adhere butterflies in Step 7 to the front of the card base as shown. I used dimensionals to pop up.
10. Cut a piece of Basic White Card Stock 4" x 5 ¼" and stamp sentiment from Sweetly Scripted in Tuxedo Black Memento Ink on the edge of the card stock as shown. Adhere Basic White Card Stock piece to inside of the card.
