    - ii. Chris mentioned their **need for volunteers to dead-head roses** (which is cutting off the old roses that have gone by) every **Mon, Wed, Fri from 9 to Noon**.
      1. They provide the pruning supplies, including gloves and provide instructions for newbies. Volunteers should wear long sleeves and pants.
      2. You don't have to sign-up ahead of time; you can just come and go at any time from 9 to noon.
      3. You have to be able to negotiate going over the low-lying boxwood bush hedges to get into some of the garden area

  - a. **Saving Rosemont Court** (Don)
    - i. Trell Anderson, the NWAHA Exec Dir, said they are still anticipating the final signing and starting renovations in July
      1. A recent Land-use permit was obtained through the City to install a new, larger HVAC system on the roof. Trell said they had secured Portland clean energy funds for that kind of an upgrade.
    - ii. Jennifer Brinkman, a near-by neighbor of RC, was concerned about an overflowing small garbage can near her fence that's loaded mainly with dog poop, and she said it looks like the grounds haven't been mowed or tended recently.
      1. Don will provide her with the RC contact email addresses where she can email her concerns
