## **Attendance**

- Welcome Intro Robyn Lester, President of Booster Club, called meeting to order.
- 2. **Treasurer Report** Melanie provided an update on the Booster account balance of \$42,898. Two open fundraisers: Baseball and wrestling. Cheer closed and money transferred. Marco's Pizza was behind on invoices but caught up now. Apparel \$4,200 to be paid.
- 3. Athletics Director Report AD Dunbar gave an update:
  - Wrestiling- Regionals overnight.
  - Spring sport dates are out on website.
  - Basketball Friday girls last game.
  - Basketball Boys were in 3<sup>rd</sup> place and final standings will be coming out. Week of 21<sup>st</sup> host playoff game maybe
  - Incoming 9<sup>th</sup> grade parents and future May 15<sup>th</sup> AD can speak with parents.
  - Mower Contract over \$6,300. Keeping lease and maintenance as most cost-effective thing to do.
  - Mr. Wiggins signage and update championship boards, banners. Quote coming.
  - Reverse Raffle AD and WFHS coaches are not affiliated with it and cannot promote it.
    This event is fully run by Booster Club and parent donations.
  - Community Schools March 26 Ms. Faulkner reported Apex Friendship fell through, gate and concessions will come to WFHS. Event 9-3pm.
  - Sports specific funding Teams need to get more volunteers to get concessions open.
  - Needs: Ice machine, spring orders (@\$500-1,000), 35 stunt uniforms \$2,000, Riddle helmets expire got behind for safety Need 18 helmets \$400/ea., new weigh-in machine \$5k and \$500/yr maintenance, door branding and gym banners, Hudl membership \$7-9k, scoreboard.
  - Baseball field speakers are up but not sure on the announcer box.
  - Track & Field expenses long jump pits need covers.
  - Hosting Track and Tennis Saturday event.
  - Equity is focus, not the money, but to enable other sports to excel but reality of Expenses (referees) v. Income (ticket sales) is what no one sees. Need to have a balance because sports aren't equal but kids are equal.
  - HSOT is on. Aug. 11 or 12, 2023.
