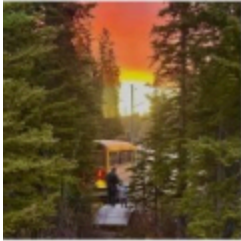


Carstairs Elementary has been fundraising to design and create our outdoor classroom.
