Cage → entrapment, being cut off, kept prisoner, "gilded cage," Connection to / Know Why the Caged Bird Sings  This is a "parrot" so I'm thinking about how it's something exotic and beautiful that is being trapped. "Outside the door" not being allowed inside (closed out) — What might the mocking-bird mean? Is it taunting the other caged bird??
Translation: "Go away!" and "Heavens" – these are the parrot's words
Connects to the cage → the idea of ownership, who has ownership and privileges in this book? – IMPORTANT THEME!
