For all students and families who register for an external credit (course(s) not provided by the Halton District School Board), the <u>HDSB External Credit Declaration Form</u> **must** be submitted to our Guidance office at the time of registration in order to be included on the student's academic record and to ensure mark transmission to post-secondary institutions. Hayden students are required to be enrolled in a minimum of three Halton courses each semester.

Student Data Transfer to Ontario College & University Application Centres

To apply to an Ontario college or university during the 2025-2026 school year, the HDSB securely sends academic and personal information to the application centres [Ontario College Application Service (OCAS) and Ontario Universities' Application Centre (OUAC)].

The first upload is on October 1, 2025. For students who will not be applying to a post-secondary institution your data is securely deleted. You may also request to opt out of the data transfer by scheduling an appointment with a Hayden Guidance Counsellor.
