#### Dear Parents/Carers

I would like to take this opportunity to welcome the Quarryhill school community back from the summer break and I look forward to meeting you all on Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> August for our first day back for the children.

### **School Meals**

P1 to 5 all receive free school meals. If you wish to apply for free meals, please go to our website to get the link to apply. If your child is in P1 to P5 and you are in receipt of benefits, please still apply for Free School Meals anyway, as you will be eligible for other benefits.

Pupils are eligible for free school meals, due to low income, if their parents or carers receive one of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Job Seeker's Allowance

- Pension Credit (Guarantee Credits)
- Any income related element of Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit, but not Working Tax Credit, with an income of less than £17,005
- Both Child Tax Credit and Working Tax Credit with an income of up to £7,920
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Universal Credit with a monthly earned income of not more than £660
- Universal Credit, with a single parent/carer working less than 16 hours per week with an annual earned income from employment of less than £17,005
- Universal Credit, with both parents/carers working less than 24 hours per week with an annual earned income from employment of less than £17,005

If children are having a packed lunch, please make sure that this is brought to school by the pupil in the morning and not dropped off during the morning at the office.

# Communication

We will continue to communicate with parents via Newsletters, Seesaw, Groupcall and phone calls. Teachers may be available at the end of the school day for an informal discussion or alternatively, we can make a suitable time for you to meet with them.

#### Medication

All medication must be approved by a member of the SLT. If your child requires long term medication or inhalers, we will organise for the paperwork to be sent home. Parents must call the school office to discuss this and then bring this to the office to be signed in.

All the staff at Quarryhill Primary School are very much looking forward to the new session and supporting you in helping your children to achieve their best.
