This course is an overview of health careers and overriding principles central to all health professions. The course provides a foundation for further study in the field of health science. Students will examine how technological developments have shaped the health sciences through history. They will explore anatomy and physiology, and how the human body is affected by disease. There will be discussion of privacy, ethics, and safety issues in health science work. Students will learn about the importance of communication and teamwork in the healthcare environment. And students will review the requirements for health science careers.
