NORFOLK-FITZGIBBINS AGREEMENT

Bentley Party (associated)

After the ratification of this agreement, all parties must uphold the following promises. If either party breaks this agreement, they can be subject to attack by the Phillip Military. This agreement will need to be renewed on 1 January 2024.

VP Luke Fitzgibbins and the Butter Butta Bentley Party promises to:

- Not write any bill relating to the restriction of suffrage for individuals over the age of 15, such as VP Luke Fitzgibbins' "Family Voting Bill"
- Not support a bill of the similar vein brought into the National Assembly by another party
- Not pass an executive order relating to the restriction of suffrage for individuals over the age of 15
- Not publicly denounce or pressure members with political favors to vote for bills

Minister Cooper Norfolk promises to:

- Disband the PNF
- Remain an independent politician until the renewal of this agreement
- Never run for President or be a candidate's Vice President
- Never run for Minister of Mint
- Post all National Assembly Bills to the public before voting starts
