Affirmative	Interrogative	Negative
I think.	Do I think?	I do not think.
You think.	Do you think?	You do not think.
He thinks.	Does he think?	He does not think.
She thinks.	Does she think?	She does not think.
It thinks.	Does it think?	It does not think.
We think.	Do we think?	We do not think.
They think.	Do they think?	They do not think.

3rd person singular

When to use it?

- to talk about things that happen regularly (pokud mluvíme o věcech, které se dějí pravidelně) - I go to the gym every Sunday.
- to talk about facts that are generally true (pokud mluvíme o faktech, která jsou obecně pravdivá) - It rains a lot in Britain.
