### **State Contact Duties**

- 1. Fill out the NEA Democratic Caucus Leadership Google Form
- 2. Join the NEA Democratic Caucus Facebook Page.
- 3. You must be an NEA Democratic Caucus Member in Good Standing
  - Note all State contact must be approved by the NEA Democratic Caucus Board
- 4. **Annual Reports**: Send an annual report about your State to <a href="mailto:nea.dem.caucus@gmail.com">nea.dem.caucus@gmail.com</a> Some ideas about what to include are <a href="mailto:HERE">HERE</a>
- 5. Duties during the RA
  - **a.** Sit at the NEA Democratic Caucus table during the RA for at least one 2 hour shift or find a proxy
  - b. During your RA State Caucus meetings, share information about the caucus and sign up members using our website <u>neademocrats.org</u> and the NEA <u>Democratic Caucus 2024 RA Info Sheet</u>
  - c. Attended caucus meetings during the RA
- 6. Duties throughout the year
  - a. Help recruit non delegate volunteers to sit at the NEA Climate Justice booth when the RA is held in your State.
  - Share information about the caucus and sign up members using our website <u>neademocrats.org</u> and the <u>NEA Democratic Caucus 2024 Info</u> Sheet
  - c. Start a Climate Justice Caucus in your state affiliate (optional).
  - d. Attend virtual caucus leadership meetings

# **Regional Director Duties**

- 1. Fill out the NEA Democratic Caucus Leadership Google Form
- 2. Join the NEA Democratic Caucus Facebook Page
- 3. You must be an NEA Democratic Caucus Member in Good Standing
  - **a.** Note all Regional Directors must be approved by the NEA Democratic Caucus Board
- 4. Fulfill the State contact duties for your state if there is no state contact yet.
- Annual Reports: Send an annual report about your Region to nea.dem.caucus@gmail.com

- 6. Duties during the RA
  - a. **Duties during the RA** Sit at the NEA Democratic Caucus table during the RA for at least **two** 2 hour shift or find a proxy
  - b. Recruit State Contacts (See Tips for recruitment below)
    - i. Recruit State contacts for each state in your your Region
    - ii. Attended caucus leadership meetings during the RA

- a. Provide information and support to your state contacts throughout the year
- b. Look for a State Contact person for each state in your your Region
- c. Attended virtual caucus leadership meetings.

## **National Director Duties**

- 1. Fill out the NEA Democratic Caucus Leadership Google Form
- 2. Join the NEA Democratic Caucus Facebook Page
- 3. You must be an NEA Democratic Caucus Member in Good Standing
  - **a.** The National Director must be approved by the NEA Democratic Caucus Board
- 4. Fulfill the State contact duties for your state if there is no state contact yet.
- 5. **Annual Reports**: Send an annual report about your Region to <a href="mailto:nea.dem.caucus@gmail.com">nea.dem.caucus@gmail.com</a>. Some ideas about what to include are <a href="mailto:HERE">HERE</a>
- 6. Duties during the RA
  - a. Sit at the NEA Democratic Caucus table during the RA for at least **three** 2 hour shifts or find a proxy.
  - b. Recruit Regional Directors
    - i. Recruit a Regional Director for each of the six Regions
    - ii. Attended caucus leadership meetings during the RA

#### 7. Duties throughout the year

- a. Provide information and support to the six regional directors throughout the year
- b. Help find Regional Coordinator for all six Regions
- c. Attended virtual caucus leadership meetings.

#### **Member in Good Standing**

This means any person who has fulfilled the requirements for membership and who has not voluntarily withdrawn nor been expelled or suspended by the union. "Good standing" requires the timely payment of dues.
