

Begin with a Dream



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Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Begin with a Dream (159143)
- **Card Stock** – Basic White (159276) Vellum Cardstock (101856)
- **Stamp Pads** – 2022-24 In Color Ink Pad Bundle (161108)
- **Misc.** – 2022-24 In Color Twine , Stylish Shapes Dies (159183)

Instructions:

1. Score the 8.5" x 7.5" piece of Basic White Cardstock along the 7.5" edge so that finished card is 8.5" long x 3.25"
2. Fold card along score line
3. On the 8.25" x 3 3/8" piece of Basic White Cardstock stamp the hearts from the Begin with a Drea stamp set using the 2022-24 In Color Ink Pad Bundle.
tip – start at the bottom stamping first heart off paper and work your colors going up as seen in photo above. Make sure to clean stamp between colors.
4. Stamp the heart on the 3" x 3" piece of Basic White Cardstock with the Sweet Sorbet ink pad from the 2022-24 In Color Ink Pad Bundle by first stamping the inked stamp on a scrap piece of paper then stamping heart without reinking
5. Stamp greeting from stamp set using the Starry Sky Ink pad from the 2022-24 In Color Ink Pad Bundle
6. Die cut the 3" x 3" piece with a square from the Stylish Shapes die set
7. Die cut the 3" x 3" piece of Cardstock Vellum from the Stylish Shapes set so that it is one size bigger to layer behind the greeting.
8. Adhere the greeting square to the vellum square
9. Wrap a length of all 5 2022-24 In Color twine around the Basic White Cardstock with the stamped hearts.
Tip – secure to back using tear and tape for best hold
10. Layer the Basic White cardstock with stamp hearts to score and folded piece of Basic White cardstock.
Tip – use dimensionals or foam strips
11. Layer Greeting to cardfront as seen using dimensionals
12. Add greeting of choice and or handwritten message to inside.
