 - With much prayer, conversation, and congregational feedback, we have determined that
 we will be meeting in-person once per month for the foreseeable future, with weekly
 online worship on the other Sunday. We are coming to learn that providing a periodic,
 safe, public Worship Gathering is one way that we can carry out our mission and vision
 to live life with God in community for the neighborhood.
 - Our next two opportunities for in-person worship will be August 9 and September 13.
- Neighbor RAFT assistance: RAFT provides short-term financial assistance to low-income families who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless. Many neighbors need this aid but need help filling out the form.
 - 5 Spanish-speaking Resurrection Church members are teaming up with Vecindarios Unidos de East Boston (United Neighborhood of Eastie) to help Spanish-speaking neighbors fill out these forms and access RAFT aid.
 - As more neighbors need help, we are exploring the possibilities of an "assembly line" that can utilize both our Spanish speaking skills and also our English-only members who want to help. Scripture Reading (English) - 1 Corinthians 15:50-58 (ESV) - Kaitlin

⁵⁰ I tell you this, brothers and sisters: flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable. ⁵¹ Behold! I tell you a mystery. We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, ⁵² in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed.⁵³ For this perishable body must put on the imperishable, and this mortal body must put on immortality. ⁵⁴ When the perishable puts on the imperishable, and the mortal puts on immortality, then shall come to pass the saying that is written:

"Death is swallowed up in victory."

55 "O death, where is your victory?

O death, where is your sting?"

⁵⁶ The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. ⁵⁷ But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. ⁵⁸ Therefore, my beloved brothers and sisters, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain.
