Introduction

This document represents an ongoing effort to catalogue the world's philosophical autobiographies.

For the purposes of this project, a “philosophical autobiography” means either:

1. An autobiography or memoir by a philosopher.
2. An autobiography or memoir by someone whose work is largely recognized as philosophy.
3. A work of philosophy that either contains or is predicated upon strong autobiographical components.

Works that do not quite fit these definitions, but come close or are aligned in spirit, are filed under “Edge Cases.”

Usage Notes

Texts are listed alphabetically by author. However, where an author has published multiple autobiographical works, these texts are arranged chronologically by original publication date.

Each top-level entry in the list is meant to be a recent English-language version. Original language versions or older editions/translations are listed as subordinate entries. Works without suitable English translations are listed under “Works Unavailable in English.”

Hyperlinks to print and online versions are included where possible, noting whether the online version deviates from the linked printed version.

This document allows suggestions via comments. Additions or corrections are welcomed, but are subject to review.
