- Student Devices: iPads and Chromebooks
 - Principal Richins explains the topic
 - Principal Price started 9th grade iPad initiative
 - District has been using Chromebooks for 10+ years
 - 70% of teachers prefer Chromebooks
 - 65% of 9th grade students prefer Chromebooks
 - There are restrictions on iPads
 - Far fewer iPads have needed repairs
 - Deirdra Patterson
 - Her students do not like using iPads at school
 - She believes it makes sense to use Chromebooks if that is what students use in elementary school and high school
 - Emily Castleton
 - Could be useful to have iPads on a cart for classes to use when needed
 - Benefit of iPads: It can be helpful to learn a new tool in 9th grade

 - Money is being spent on substitutes for PLC days

 - Digital citizenship: appropriate use of technology
 - Entire unit in 7th grade on digital safety
 - BARK: software
