3. Review of MOY Data

Concerns K1

K-3 down to 49% from 54% BOY- however they were tested 6 weeks early Statewide they have seen this impact

4-6 great improvement from 43% up to 69%

Sara asked if we are seeing some improvement with the current kindergartners that had pre-school last year? Principal Webster said yes there is normal growth and learning- and they have noticed that state wide.

The mirrors have had huge success in helping the kids with the specific sounds: T, H, C, F

4. ESSER Intervention Plans

K: tutoring in mornings; Friday morning to read with teachers early;sending specific books home weekly, SeeSaw

- 1: Sending home fluency passages based on needs; fluency notes weekly
- 2: custom paper packets in math/fluency
- 3: morning tutoring; extra activities
- 4: CANVAS, one on one tutoring; math videos



5: CANVAS, fluency passages SPED: tutoring in the morning

Tana Richards mentioned that she would like to see the data of the kids that are coming to the morning tutoring

5. NWEA 3rd-5th Grades

This data will be able to track kids from 3rd grade all the way to 12th grade. It is an adaptive assessment- helps teachers target their instruction. The district signed a contract- we are going to do Reading and Math. The testing will start next week for baseline screenings. A second assessment will be done after RISE. (up to 4 tests can be done a year)

-Test results are given immediately

Tana R offered that possibly after testing results are in that kids could go to their specific group of where they are at in math each day so their instruction is more personalized to each kid and where they are at.

We are super excited about this addition to our schools
