# General Range Rules

# These rules apply to all days regardless of the day of the week.

## **General rules set by USA Archery**

- ALWAYS WALK ON THE RANGE
- ★ KEEP YOUR ARROWS IN YOUR QUIVER UNTIL TOLD TO SHOOT
- ONLY RELEASE THE BOW STRING WHEN AN ARROW IS NOCKED AND SAFELY POINTED TOWARD THE TARGET
- → LEAVE DROPPED ARROWS ON THE GROUND UNTIL INSTRUCTED TO RETRIEVE THEM

IF THERE IS AN EMERGENCY ON THE RANGE IMMEDIATELY ALERT THE INSTRUCTOR



## **SLAC Range Rules**

- → One person may pull arrows from target at a time
- → Equipment Rules
  - No broadheads
  - ◆ Bows must be under #60
  - All arrows must have archer's full name written on arrow shaft
- → Archer must be able to hit all but one of their arrows in the bale 'each end' to stay at their desired distance





All shooting will be done on whistle commands from the Director of Shooting/range officer. Club officers will act as Director of Shooting/Range officer when they are present. DOS/RO will be delegated when there will not be an officer present.

# Archers arriving between after 9:00 AM

Please make every effort to pay attention to members who are scoring and try not interfering with their pace on the line. Members also have the option to set up targets (at any distance) to the left of field center and are responsible for their tear down when finished shooting.

# Those targets used for scoring should be returned to 60 yds when scoring has been completed

If no member/s wished to score a 900 round then two (2) of these targets may be moved to any distance

All other target butts will continue to be used for practice

Field tear-down after the last scoring end as usual or NO later than 3:00PM

## **Open Shooting and Class Range Rules:**

- 1. You must have your own equipment. Rental equipment will not be provided.
- 2. If it a small group we will run 1 line
  - a. 2 people per target
- 3. If there are more than 8- 10 people we will run two lines
  - a. 4 people per target
- 4. If there is a target already set up please use targets already set up and share
- 5. If there are not enough targets you must set up your own target.
  - a. How to set up a target video
- 6. Target faces must be hung according to images above ^
  - a. Please do not hang your target in the very center of the target.

#### 7. Special Indoor rules

- All archers must put their backs against the wall when waiting for their line to be called up.
- b. Do NOT walk in front of the pillars at any time (unless to retrieve arrows).
- c. All bows must be in designated areas on or by bowracks
  - Bows may NOT be kept behind the shooting line
