

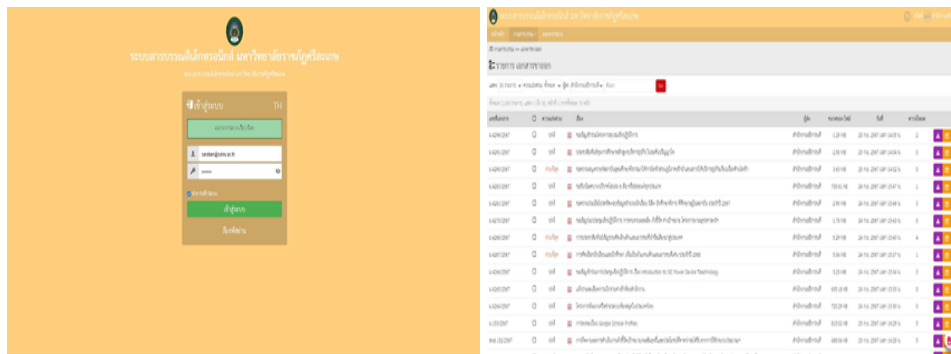

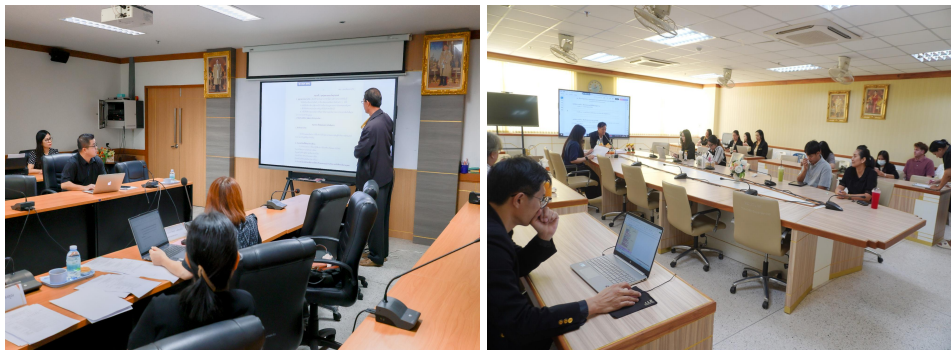

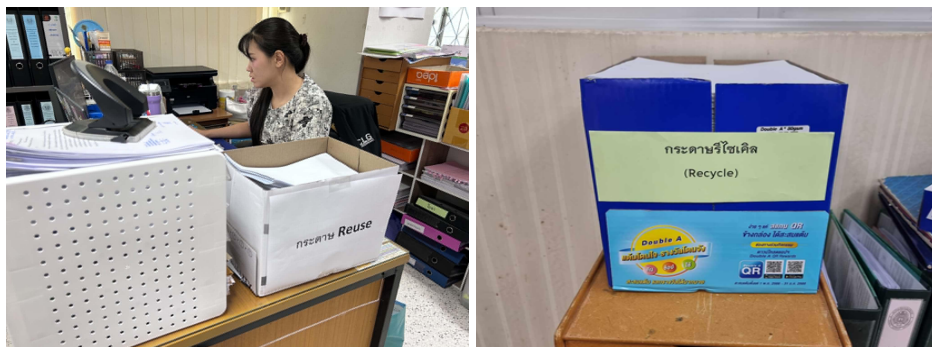

Recycling Waste Materials into Educational Learning Media for Kindergarten and Primary School Students



Program to Reduce the Use of Paper and Plastic on Campus

1. **Electronic Document Management System (e-Document System) for Paper Reduction**

Sisaket Rajabhat University has implemented an Electronic Document Management System (e-Document System) to replace paper-based administrative processes. The system supports document submission, approval, internal communication, and record management in digital form, significantly reducing paper consumption and printing requirements across the university.

2. **Online Documents for Meetings and Project Evaluations**

The university promotes the use of online documents, digital reports, and electronic files for meetings, project evaluations, and administrative activities. This initiative minimizes the need for printed documents and supports the university's paperless office policy.

3. **Paper Reduction through Double-Sided Printing Project**

Staff and students are encouraged to use double-sided printing and review documents carefully before printing. This measure helps reduce paper consumption and promotes efficient resource utilization.

4. **Single-Sided Paper Reuse Project**

Paper printed on only one side is collected and reused for internal communication, drafts, and administrative work, extending the life cycle of paper resources and reducing paper waste.

5. **Online Payslip Request System**

The university has developed an online payslip request system that allows personnel to access and download salary slips electronically instead of using carbon-copy forms and printed documents. This system reduces paper use and improves administrative efficiency.

6. **Personal Reusable Cup Promotion Project**

Students and staff are encouraged to bring their own reusable cups and bottles instead of using disposable plastic or paper cups. The project helps reduce single-use plastic waste generated on campus.

7. **Personal Reusable Basket Project**

The university promotes the use of reusable baskets and containers for shopping and university activities to reduce dependence on plastic bags and disposable packaging.

8. **Project to Reduce the Use of Plastic Bags**

Sisaket Rajabhat University actively campaigns to reduce the use of single-use plastic bags by encouraging environmentally friendly alternatives and raising awareness among students, staff, and visitors.

9. **Project on Environmental Development towards a Sustainable Green University and Innovative Canteen Waste Management (Zero Waste Canteen)**

The university operates a Zero Waste Canteen initiative that promotes waste reduction, reusable food containers, proper waste segregation, and environmentally friendly practices within campus food service areas.

10. **Recyclable Waste and Plastic Bottle Segregation on Campus**

Waste segregation stations are installed throughout the campus to separate recyclable materials, including plastic bottles, paper, glass, and aluminum. This initiative supports recycling activities and reduces waste sent to landfill.

11. **Upcycling Scrap Fabrics into Brooches and Accessories Project**

The university supports the upcycling of scrap fabrics into brooches and accessories. This initiative reduces textile waste while creating value-added products that generate income and employment opportunities for local communities.

12. **Recycling Waste Materials into Educational Learning Media for Kindergarten and Primary School Students**

Students develop creative learning media from recycled and reusable materials for kindergarten and primary school education. The project promotes the principles of Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle (3R) while fostering environmental awareness and resource conservation among young learners.
