<p><b>Component #2: Establish a Network of Community Resources</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> HISD will compile Community Resources for families, provide information on available services, and post on social media and the HISD website.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Assisting families in obtaining and utilizing library cards will encourage engagement with educational resources.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> HISD will facilitate referrals for needed services and periodically invite different community resources to interact with families directly, making accessing resources more convenient (CASA, JPS, Compassion Counseling, Erath County Backpack Buddies, Shop with a Cop)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Component #3: Increase Family Participation in Decision Making</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> To empower families, HISD will include prek families in advisory groups/HISD Clubs and support leadership and advocacy skills (School Health Advisory Committee (SHAC), PTO, Ag and Rodeo Backers, etc...).</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Opportunities for input and feedback on key events will be presented, and families will be identified to represent prekindergarten at various school functions.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Parents will also be invited to participate in Parent-Teacher Conferences at least two times a year with the classroom teacher to support each student's academic and social/emotional learning goals.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Parents will be invited to all 504, LPAC, and Special education meetings in a timely manner.</li> </ul>
