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Abstract (150-200 words)

English abstracts made between 150-200 words contain goals, problems, methods, results and discussion. Abstracts are written using the 12-size arial, spaced 1 and with a text length between 150-200 words. The English version of the abstract is written using standard English with enhanced spelling.

Keywords: write 3-6 words concepts are core/essential/fundamental from the article, arranged alphabetically. Exs (Dialectics; Religions; Beliefs; *Suku Anak Dalam.*)

INTRODUCTION (1000-1500 words)

The introduction is written in English with Arial font and 1.5 spacing. The introduction must include the background of the problem explaining why the problem needs to be solved through research, the focus of the research so that the discussion in the research is not widened, facts from the field as concrete evidence of the research problem, useful literature review to find uniqueness and specificity in the research to be carried out.

RESEARCH METHODS (500-1000 words)

The research method is written in a clear and detailed manner and refers to references using Arial 1.5 spaced English font. Research methods include types of research, research objects, research approaches, data sources, data collection techniques, and data analysis techniques.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Findings (can be in form of subheading) (1500-2500 words)

The results and discussion are adjusted to the research approach. If the quantitative research approach consists of descriptive statistics, the results of the assumption test and



the results of hypothesis testing are then analyzed critically. If the qualitative approach is in the form of themes from the results of the qualitative analysis carried out.

Tables, Figures

Each table or figure is given a serial number, title, according to the contents of the table and figure, and the source of the citation if any. The source of the citation is written under the table or figure, Arial font size 10. The title of the table is written above the table and the title of the figure is written below the figure.

Analysis/Discussion (1000-1500 words)

Presenting the data that has been interpreted and analyzed by a specific technique and has been processed by the specific theory (also from researcher idea).

CONCLUSION (150-200 words)

The conclusion is the answer to the research objectives. This is not a summary of the research results. Conclusions and suggestions must be clear and concise based on the results and discussion.

REFERENCES

Write a number of references that are cited and really written/quoted in the text from primary sources, (70% taken from scholarly journals, 30% other supporting sources).

Writing references is done in a standard and consistent manner. To maintain consistency, quotes are written in the form of body notes and use the Mendeley application with the APA (American Psychological Association 7th edition) style.
