

The Spring 2021 Assessment Windows and Dates

Please keep in mind that these are the testing windows. You will be getting a detailed schedule of when and where your child will be doing in-person testing when we determine how many of our students are going to be in the school and how we can group them in order to do these required assessments safely.

March 29- May 14

- CMAS (CO Measures of Academic Standards)
- State Required testing; in-person
- 3rd-8th Grades in Math, Language Arts
- 5th and 8th Grades will also be tested in Science

Tuesday, April 13

- Only one day only for all College Board tests)
- State Required School Day testing; in-person
- PSAT 9 College Board for 9th grade
- PSAT 10 College Board for 10th grade
- SAT College Board for 11th grade

April 19 -May 21

- ♦ NWEA MAPs (Measures of Academic Progress)
- PSD required testing; in-person with a possible remote option
- 2nd-8th Grades in Math and Language Arts

We encourage everyone who feels comfortable with doing in-person testing to participate in these required tests. It will allow us to better tailor our instruction in the future to meet individual student needs. We also appreciate that each family needs to make decisions as to what they feel is in their own best interest.
