What type of things does Bill's Group do? When does Bill's Group meet? Where does Bill's Group meet?

- most evenings & days **on Zoom** we have very short 10-20 minute prayer times. **For night prayers** on Tuesday - Sunday nights at 9:45PM-10:05PM. Plus, some of us meet **for mid-day prayers** on some weekdays at 12:30PM for about 5-10 minutes.
- weekly **in-person** faith sharing after watching and listening to a Sunday homily, as well as
- once each month **in-person** a game night, plus,
- occasionally, **in-person**, ordinarily at Dairy Queen on Washtenaw Avenue, we celebrate the birthdays of our members.

Our in-person meetings are held at, 7PM (until 8:30PM) on most Monday evenings (when we have enough transportation available - because many of our members do not drive)... ordinarily, at St. Francis Parish youth room, (at the rectory house near St. Francis Parish Office, 2150 Frieze Ave., Ann Arbor). (But, on the game-nights - once each month on a Monday evening - we meet at a different place - an apartment-community room - at Lynden Parke Apartments, 2224 Golfside Rd., Ypsilanti. At either location, when you arrive in the parking lot just call my (Mobile:734-480-8422) number and I'll come out to show you the door to the building where we meet.

What Transportation Needs Are There?
