Award applicants can either be self-nominated or nominated by someone. To be eligible applications must complete the one page application by February 28th. An awards committee will review the applications. Awardees will be announced and honored at the Nebraska Association of Family and Consumer Sciences Regional Conference in Ames, Iowa.

Leader Award- Honors family and consumer sciences professionals who have made significant contributions to the field through their involvement with AAFCS/NAFCS

Requirements- Members must have two consecutive member years prior to nomination and more than eight years of service to the profession.

New Achiever Award- Identify and honor emerging family and consumer sciences professionals who have exhibited the potential to make significant contributions to the field through their involvement AAFCS/NAFCS.

Requirements- Members must have two consecutive members years prior to nomination and have between three and eight years of service to the profession.

Teacher of the Year Award- Recognizes FCS teachers who utilize cutting edge methods, techniques and activities to provide visibility to family and consumer sciences in elementary and secondary education.

Requirements- Nominees must have three consecutive membership years prior to submission of nomination.
