

A LEVEL LAW

CORE PREPARATION: You must complete all of these tasks:

- Complete the following activity:

‘Your ship sinks and you wash ashore on a desert island. You are soon joined by other survivors. Now you are a community, however to make sure there is order it will need rules (i.e. laws) that everyone must follow and consequences should they not be followed. Your task is to write your own constitution (i.e. set of laws) as to how the island should be governed.’



Consider how you would promote fundamental British values:

- Democracy
- Rule of Law
- Respect and Tolerance
- Individual liberty

ENRICHMENT: You should undertake at least one of these:

- Visit your local magistrates' court or crown court to watch a case and write a summary report about it (date, case facts, and judgment).
- Use a search engine and search for 'BBC Radio 4 Law in Action Podcast' and download/listen to an episode – write a paragraph on what you have learnt for your subject folder.
- Read your local newspaper and/or a good quality national newspaper (E.g. The Guardian, The Times) and collect any law stories you find, keeping them in a scrapbook.
