**? What is a Pronoun?**

A pronoun is a word used instead of a noun.  
It helps avoid repeating the same noun again and again.

✗ Ravi is a good boy.  
Ravi studies well.    vs    ✓ Ravi is a good boy.  
He studies well.

✗ "He" is a pronoun (it replaces Ravi)

✚ If a word replaces a noun, it is a pronoun.  
Sita is happy → She is happy

**🔥 Quick Summary**  
✚ Pronoun = replaces noun  
✚ Makes sentences short & clear  
✚ Common words: he, she, it, they, this, who

### ✓ What is a Pronoun?

A **pronoun** is a word used **instead of a noun**.

✚ It helps avoid repeating the same noun again and again.

✚ Example:

- ✗ Ravi is a good boy. **Ravi** studies well. ✗
- ✓ Ravi is a good boy. **He** studies well. ✓

✚ He is a **pronoun** (it replaces Ravi)

### 📌 Types of Pronouns (Easy)

#### 1. 👤 Personal Pronouns

Used for **people or things**

✚ I, You, He, She, It, We, They

✚ Examples:

- ✚ I am a student
- ✚ She is my sister
- ✚ They are playing

#### 2. 📦 Possessive Pronouns

Show **ownership**

✚ Mine, Yours, His, Hers, Ours, Theirs

✚ Examples:

- This book is **mine**
- That house is **theirs**

### 3. 🖐️ Demonstrative Pronouns

Point to something

🖐️ This, That, These, Those

📌 Examples:

- **This** is my pen
- **Those** are my friends

### 4. ❓ Interrogative Pronouns

Used to **ask questions**

🖐️ Who, What, Which, Whose

📌 Examples:

- **Who** are you?
- **What** is this?

### 5. 🔗 Relative Pronouns

Join two sentences / give more info

🖐️ Who, Which, That, Whose

📌 Examples:

- The boy **who** is playing is my brother
- The book **that** I read is good

### 6. ↺ Reflexive Pronouns

Used when subject = object (same person)

🖐️ Myself, Yourself, Himself, Herself, Itself, Ourselves, Themselves

📌 Examples:

- I did it **myself**
- She hurt **herself**

### 7. 🌐 Indefinite Pronouns

Refer to **unknown or general people/things**

🖐️ Someone, Anyone, Everyone, Something, Nothing

📌 Examples:

- **Someone** is calling you
- **Everyone** is happy



# Easy Trick to Identify Pronoun

👉 If a word **replaces a noun**, it is a **pronoun**

📌 Example:

- Sita is happy → **She** is happy



## Quick Summary

👉 Pronoun = replaces noun

👉 Makes sentences **short & clear**

👉 Common words: **he, she, it, they, this, who**
