

Marching Band 2020-21 Outdoor Rehearsal Protocols

Students and Instructors will follow all guidance from the CDC, MHSAA, IUL and State of Michigan

Before Rehearsal:

1. Parents conduct a [pre-screening](#) of your child at home
2. Instructors and Coaches will have temperature taken and a health screening prior to interaction with students.
3. Parents will drop off their students at the appointed location and must stay in their car.
4. Students will arrive at the gate near the band room door (9S). If the gate is closed, do not touch it or enter. X's will be marked on the pavement to enforce social distancing while students are waiting for their health screening.
5. Students will arrive 15 minutes prior to designated start time with their mask on to have their temperature taken by a staff member and answer the following questions. Answers will be recorded.
 - a. Do you have a cough?
 - b. Do you have a fever?
 - c. Do you have a sore throat?
 - d. Do you have shortness of breath?
 - e. Have you been around anyone with Covid-19 Symptoms?

During Rehearsal:

6. Detailed attendance records will be kept for all rehearsals
7. Students must remain socially distanced at all times (at least 6ft apart)
8. Masks must be worn outdoors when not able to be socially distanced
9. Students are assigned to their sections and will not mix with other groups
10. Students must bring their own water bottle with their name on it
11. There is to be no shared food or beverages
12. Students must bring all of their own instruments, sticks, mallets, etc
 - a. There will be NO sharing of personal equipment allowed
13. Students will not be allowed into the building
14. Restrooms are for emergency use only - only one student at a time will access restroom - and will be required to wear a mask at all times while in the building
15. Students and Instructors will use hand sanitizer and wash hands regularly during rehearsals.

After Rehearsal:

16. Students must leave immediately following practice
17. Parents waiting for their child must stay in their car
18. Any common equipment (marimbas, podiums etc) must be thoroughly disinfected before and after use.
19. Instructors will be diligent in disinfecting any equipment that has been exposed immediately after use.
20. There will be no physical contact between students (hand shakes, high-fives, fist-bumps, hugs, etc)
