





## Google Forms Features for Lessons and Tutorials

One great feature is "**Go to Section Based on Answer**". This feature is available in the Question Options section of Multiple Choice or Dropdown questions in the Forms Editor.







# Using Go to Page Based on Answer

In order for this option to work best, you need to separate questions or question sets by section.

To add a section:


- 1. Click on the icon in the floating toolbar.
- 2. Name your section.
- 3. After you create them, section names will appear as options next to answers.






# Marking your questions...

After you have created Sections, you can go back to any Multiple Choice or Dropdown question type and enable "Go to Section Based on Answer". Then you'll have the ability to mark which answers guide you to which section....



### Take the Adventure One Step Further


Sometimes you have the need to gather information from people, but in the process, you want to eliminate options as they are chosen. Google Forms has AddOns that make this possible. Try this one...

#### **Choice Eliminator 2**



Choice Eliminator lets you choose how many times an answer / option is used.

#### To Get This Add On:



- 2. Choose Add Ons
- 3. Search for Choice Eliminator 2
- 4. Click Free next to the Add On.

#### To Use this Add On:

- 1. Click on the Add On icon (Puzzle Piece)
- 2. Choose Choice Eliminator 2
- 3. Click Configure
- 4. A Menu will popup at the right of your form.
- 5. Choose the Question to apply this feature.
- Place a Check in the Box.
- 7. Click the Gear to modify options.
