**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER VII,
TRAFFIC, OF AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE
ADOPTING AND ENACTING THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES
OF THE CITY OF LINDEN, 1999," PASSED NOVEMBER 23, 1999 AND
APPROVED NOVEMBER 24, 1999, AND AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED**

Amend Chapter VII, Traffic, as follows:

Chapter VII, Traffic

7-33 HANDICAPPED PARKING REGULATIONS

7-33.1A Handicapped Parking On-Street

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>No. of Spaces</u>	<u>Location</u>
ADD: 816 East Henry Street	1	On the southeasterly sideline of East Henry Street, 175 feet more or less northeasterly from the projection of the northeasterly curbline of McCandless Street in front of 816 East Henry Street for a length of 22 feet. The aforesaid space is specifically reserved and designated for a vehicle for Valerie Scott to be identified by license plate number and a placard to be issued by the City, and no other vehicle bearing or displaying handicapped license plates and/or placards, or not, shall be permitted to park in such space.
916 West Henry Street	1	On the northwesterly sideline of West Henry Street, 34 feet more or less northeasterly from the projection of the northeasterly curbline of Lindegard Street in front of 916 West Henry Street for a length of 22 feet. The aforesaid space is specifically reserved and designated for a vehicle for Deborah Jones to be identified by license plate number and a placard to be issued by the City, and no other vehicle bearing or displaying handicapped license plates and/or placards, or not, shall be permitted to park in such space.
1515 Winans Avenue	1	On the northeasterly sideline of Winans Avenue, 82 feet more or less northwesterly from the projection of the northwesterly curbline of West 16 th Street in front of 1515 Winans Avenue for a length of 22 feet. The aforesaid space is specifically reserved and designated for a vehicle for Liliana M. Giraldo to be identified by license plate number and a placard to be issued by the City, and no other vehicle

bearing or displaying handicapped license plates and/or placards, or not, shall be permitted to park in such space.
