Unlike the B&I program, the B&I Cares Act, agricultural producers are eligible. There are no size restrictions. However, there are eligibility requirements, including business must be located in a rural area as defined by USDA.

AGRICULTURAL BUSINESSES

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- USDA B&I CARES Act Program: A 90% loan guarantee program open until September 2021. Loan proceeds can be used for working capital (loan payments, payroll, inventory etc.) to prevent, prepare and respond to the pandemic. Maximum loan amount is \$25 million. However, there are eligibility requirements, including business must be located in a rural area as defined by USDA.
