


## Explore Google Creativity – Google Search Easter Eggs

Easter Egg



- **Friends**

- Type the name of a Friends character in [Google search](#). Click on the icon on the right for some Friends nostalgia.
- Bonus: "friends glossary" will show definitions for quotes in the show

- **Mr C The Slide Man**

- Type "cha-cha slide" in [Google search](#). Click on the icons to keep dancing.

- **Paddington**

- Type "Paddington" in Google search. Click the sandwich to start tossing.

- **Katamari**

- Type "katamari" in [Google search](#). Click on the Katamari ball and start playing.

- **Cats and Dogs**

- Type "cats" or "dogs" in [Google search](#). Find the paw and start clicking.

- **Georges Seurat**

- Type "Georges Seurat" in [Google search](#). Find and click on the painting to learn about pointillism.

- **Solar Eclipse**

- Type “solar eclipse” in [Google search](#). Experience the eclipse. 

- **Mario Brothers**

- Type “mario brothers” in [Google search](#). Click on the question 

- **The Last of Us**

- Type “the last of us” or “cordyceps” in [Google search](#). Click on the red mushroom  that appears on the bottom of the screen. 

- **Breathing Exercise**

- Type “breathing exercise” in [Google search](#). Click on play for a minute of mindfulness 

■ Bonus: Click on the carrot  to explore some fun “Games & Toys” | “Tools”

- **BTS**

- Type “bts” in Google search. Click on the purple heart  and start popping some balloons. This one is best with the sound on!

- **Askew and Dart Mission**

- Type “askew” in [Google search](#).  Typing in “dart mission” will create a similar effect.

- **Splatoon**

- Type “splatoon” in [Google search](#). Click on the colorful splat  to start decorating the search results.

- **Random Number Generator / Spinner**

- Type “spinner” in [Google search](#). This opens a customizable (up to 20 numbers) random number wheel. We no longer need to hold our fingers behind our backs.  It also doubles as a fidget spinner.  You can also type “random number generator” for a simpler version.

- **Meteorite**

- Type “chicxulub” or “meteorite” will show an asteroid falling on the results page. Then, the whole page will shake slightly. 

- **Ask a Question**

- Type “fun facts” in [Google search](#). A random question and answer will appear. Click on “Ask Another Question” for even more knowledge. 

- **Play More Games**

- Type “play snake” in [Google search](#). Click “Play”. You can also do the same with “play pacman” and “play tic tac toe”.  You can also see even more games and tools by clicking on the down arrow.

- **Animal Sounds**

- Type “what sound does a dog make” (no question mark) in [Google search](#). This will load an interactive collection of animal cards with sounds. 

- **Drop Bear**

- Type “drop bear” in [Google search](#). Click on the Koala Bear  sign to watch a Koala Bear to drop through the search results. ([What is a drop bear?](#))

- **Earth Day Quiz**

- Type “earth day quiz” in [Google search](#). Answer the questions to discover your spirit animal. 

- **Do A Barrel Roll**
  - Type “do a barrel roll” in [Google search](#). Experience a virtual barrel roll. 
- **Google Doodles**
  - Google maintains a search [collection of Doodles](#). Many of these are interactive, one favorite is creating your own video game with [Jerry Lawson's Doodle](#) 
- **DVD Screensaver**
  - Type “dvd screensaver” in [Google search](#). The Google logo  on the top left corner of the screen to bounce around the screen, shifting colors between blue, red, yellow, and green every time it hits the page boundaries.
- **Googly Eyes**
  - Type “googly eyes” in [Google search](#). The O’s in the Google logo will be replaced with googly eyes  that follow your mouse.
- **Holidays**
  - Search for a specific holiday in Google Search. Many popular holiday searches like “christmas” , “hanukkah” , “kwanzaa” , “diwali” , “ramadan” , “holi” , and more have Easter Eggs in the search results.
- **Legally Blonde**
  - Type “legally blonde” in [Google search](#). Click on the pink purse  to learn more about Elle and Bruiser.
- **Mars Perseverance Rover**
  - Type “mars 2020” in [Google search](#). Click on the rover helicopter  to explore Mars.
- **Google Birthday Surprise**
  - Type “google birthday surprise spinner” in [Google search](#). The wheel will randomly select a playable Google Doodle.
- **Forest Gump**
  - Type “forest gump” in [Google search](#). A runner appears at the top of the screen with more runners following him as he runs. 
- **Dinner for One**
  - Search "dinner for one" in [Google search](#). Click on the grey tiger head  to activate an animation on the bottom of the screen. 
- **Wordle**
  - Search "wordle" in [Google search](#). This will turn the Google logo into a round of Wordle and guess the words COLUMN, GOALIE, and GOOGLE.

Google Search Easter Eggs do occasionally disappear or are “discontinued”. Some of my old favorites like Zerg Rush don’t seem to work anymore, but there are many more to explore. gems at any given moment. Some of these don't always seem to load with Educational Google Accounts.
