Pleasant Street Gear List

In addition to the traditional school supplies, we are asking families to provide gear so that students can engage fully in our growing Outdoor Education program at Pleasant Street this year.

To help your child feel comfortable, safe, and ready to explore at P Street, we ask that families send in specific outdoor gear to be kept at school. Students will be outdoors in a variety of weather conditions throughout the year. Please label all items with your child's name.

Essential Gear (Leave at School):

- **Waterproof rain jacket** (large enough to layer over a fleece or sweatshirt)
- **Rain pants or puddle pants**
- **Waterproof boots** (insulated Bogs recommended for year round)
- **Warm mittens or gloves**
- **Fleece or warm mid-layer** (e.g. zip-up fleece or hoodie)
- **Warm hat** (for cold days)
- **Sun hat** (wide-brimmed or cap style)
- **Extra socks** (2 pairs, wool or synthetic)
- **Snow pants or bibs for winter**
- **Warm winter jacket for winter**
- **Neck warmer or gaiter** (optional but helpful) for winter
- **Bug Spray**

- **Sunscreen**

A Note on Buying Gear

We recognize that quality gear can be a financial investment. However, the right gear makes a big difference in your child's comfort and experience outdoors. We encourage families to start with just the essentials and check local resale stores or gear swaps for affordable options. Look for waterproof outer layers, warm mid-layers, and boots that can withstand mud, snow, and everything in between.

Recommended brands include:

REI, Bogs, LL Bean, Polarn O. Pyret, Reima, Columbia, and Lands' End. Online retailers like Sierra Trading Post, Outdoor School Shop, and REI often carry discounted outdoor clothing.
