4. Integrity pledge is uploaded on the college website.

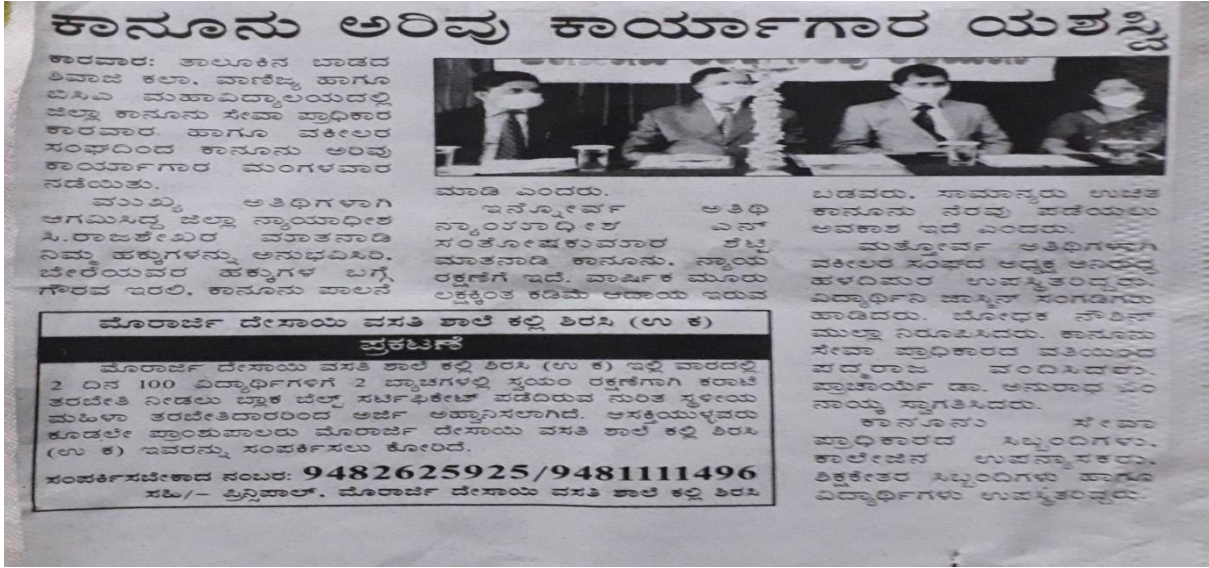
Youth week program

Workshop on Green Village, Clean Village



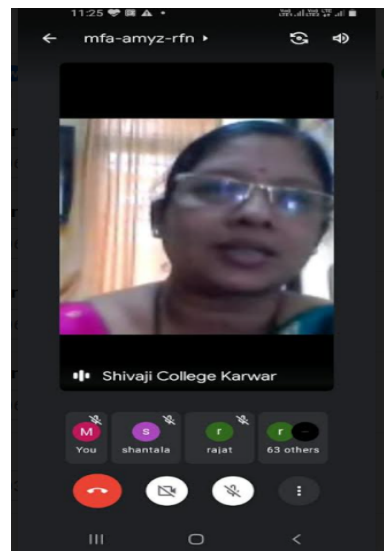
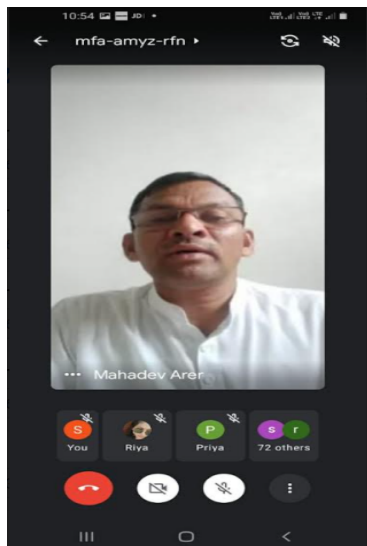

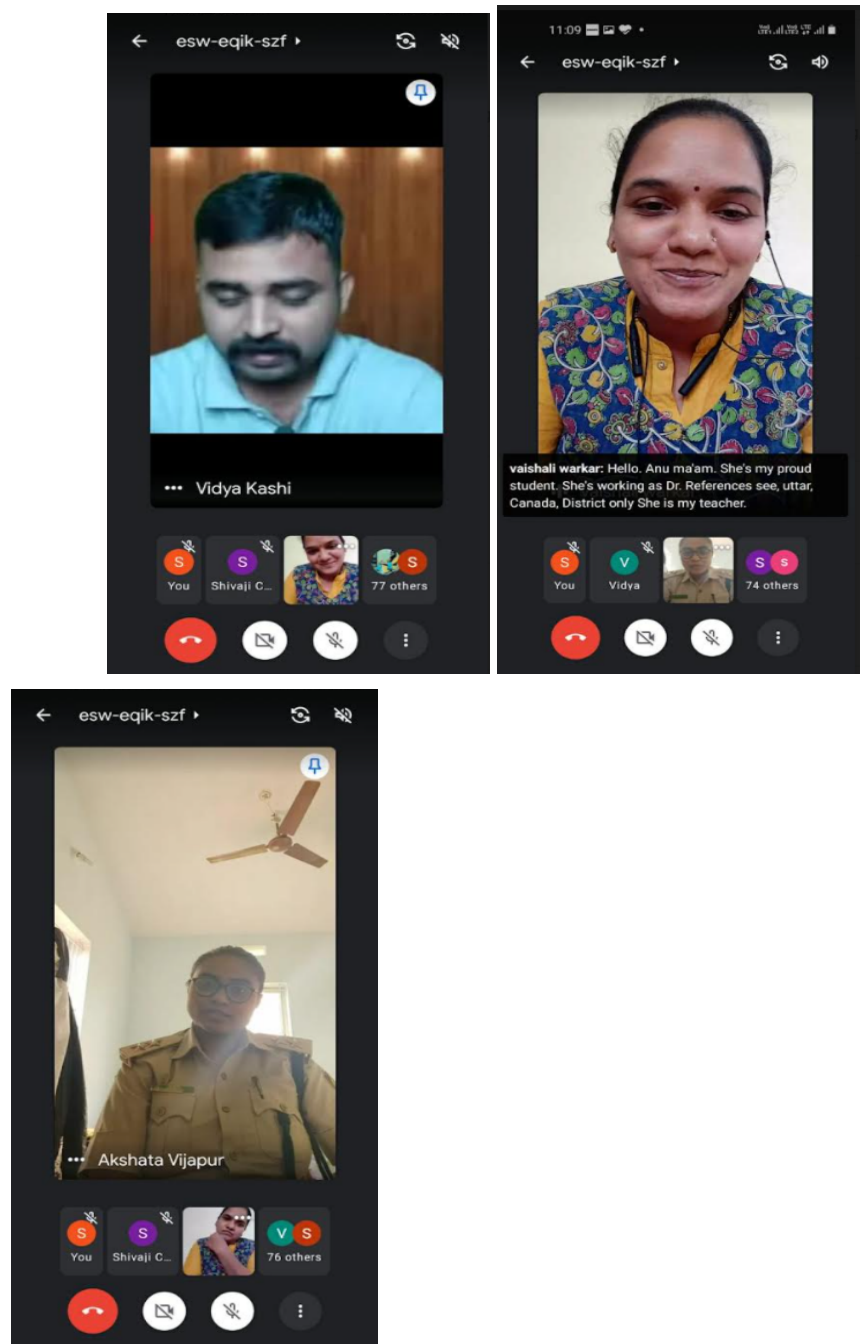
State Level Webinar on Yoga

On 26-11- 2020, Constitution Day was celebrated in our college jointly by NSS and the Department of Political Science. An online program was

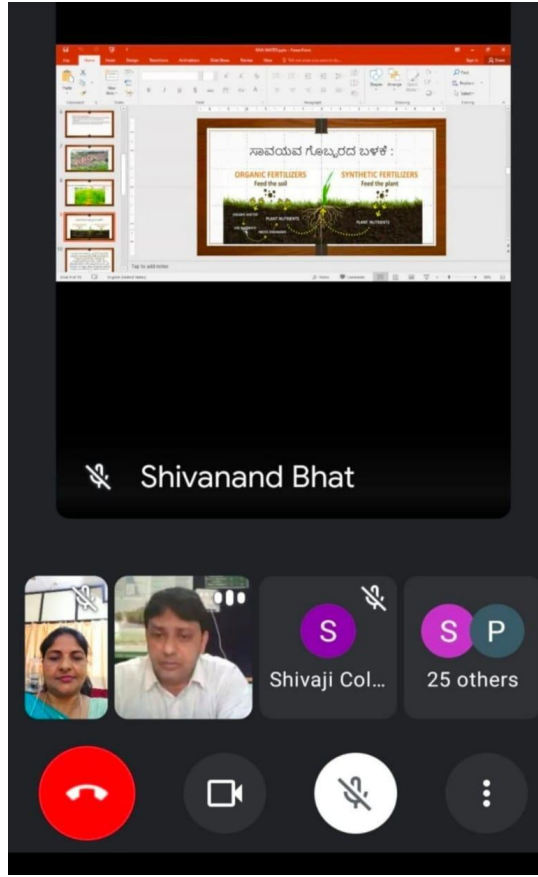

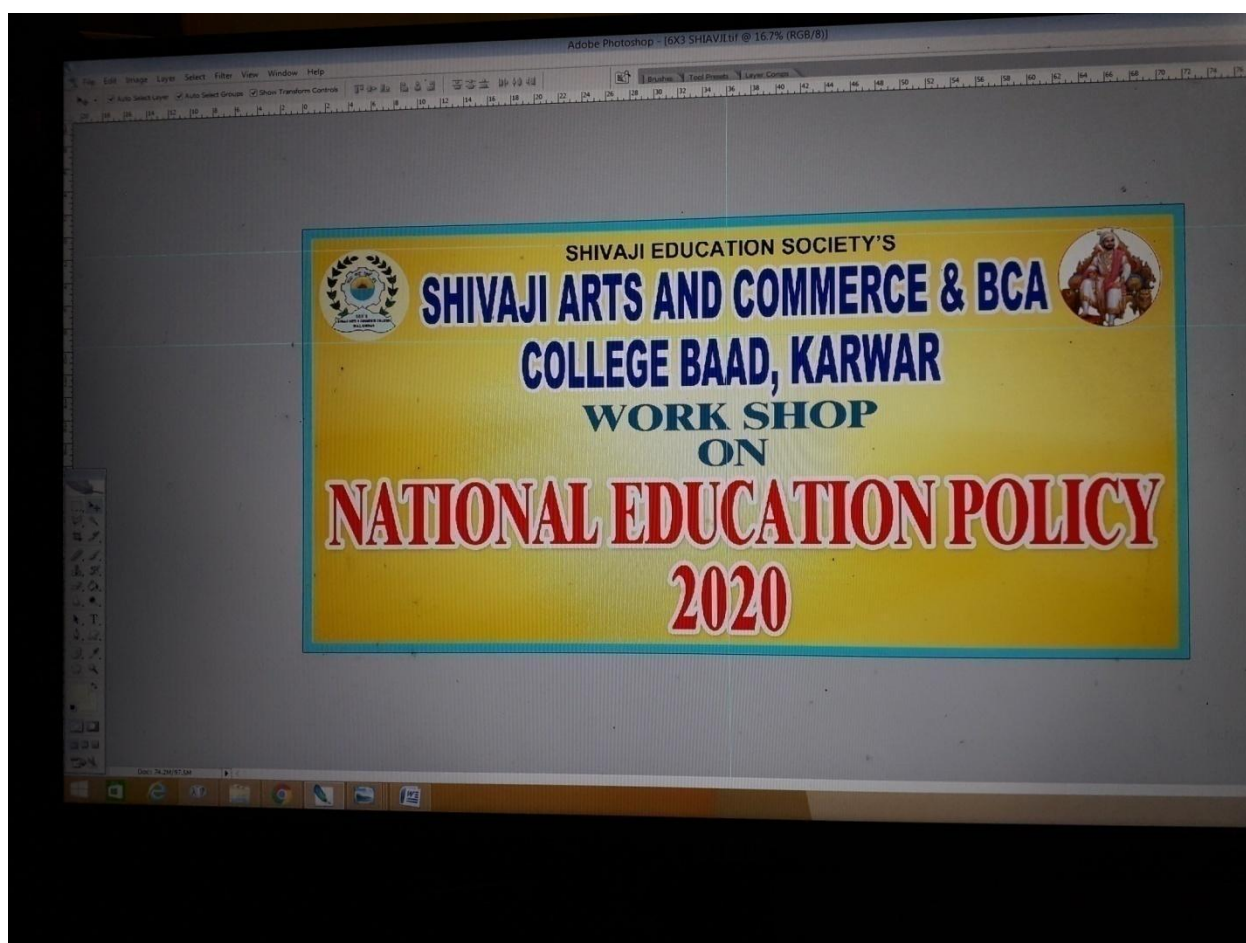
State level Webinar on 'Catch The Rain'
