February 19 - Molly Ryan

- Need more storage space throughout school
- Need more outlets spaced throughout each classroom

February 19 - M Walz

- Need charging stations throughout the school for the students to use for their devices.
- Is there a new modern concept with respect to lockers in schools? At this point in time, very few lockers are used in this school. Another 5 years, it might be a different story. Maybe the backpack ban will come back.

February 20-Miskulin

- Overhead outlets in 2D room
- Better ventilation/higher ceiling in 3D room
- More storage possibly room 39 with door between room 36 and 39

February 20 - Troy Talford

- Anytime we can add width to the hallways....let's do it!
- Having a variety of seating in the commons (tall tables vs short)
- Is there a way of having all Career & Technical Education rooms in a similar relative location in the building? This includes Agriculture, Tech Ed, Business Ed, Family & Consumer Sciences.
- Consider where rooms for students with special needs are located. Probably not a great idea to have them next to louder rooms like music rooms or shop spaces.

February 20--Mike Carpenter

- Take three of the new classrooms and make them new Business Education rooms where the computer labs can be resigned for more efficient space. All computers facing one way and ability to swing chairs around to work at a desk. (Computer Lab at

- Waunakee High School is a great example). Since you will be wiring for the new office computers, computer labs close by would be effective in the wiring for everything.

- The location of the ALC room needs to be in an academic wing with no distractions (ex: bike storage, etc.).

February 21-M. Fingerson

- More cabinets in classrooms that lock so that there is plenty of space to put items when classrooms are used for other activities.

February 22- S. Grimes

- Repair many original exterior brick walls(cover with tin) that allow driving rains to leak in building
- Replace many exterior entrance way frames that are rusted through bases
- Replace main electrical panel room for HS it seems to be coming away from wall and settling
- Repair all leaking Victaulic fittings (heating pipes) in ceilings from 1997
- Address many flooding issues in parking lot on north end and on 9 th street area
- Do not have downspouts from roof draining by entrance ways which cause ice to form by entrance ways
- Provide much storage for sports teams
- Repair some cast iron roof drain pipes that leak with hard rains

- As we incorporate more portfolio work, conferencing, etc. into classes (this is already happening in several departments!), teachers will be in need of more access to secondary spaces that are still in proximity to their classrooms. - More handicap accessible exterior entrances (with power doors) with aprons on the sidewalk straight out from the door to get bikes or wheelchairs down without jumping the curb. Specifically doors W-13 and W-17.
- Fix drainage by the current football stadium east entrance.
- One lowered or cut-out handicap accessible bench in the greenhouse.

- Electric car charging stations in the parking area (fee based)

We should look at having adult sized changing tables in the pool bathrooms for male and female bathrooms as well as family bathrooms.

February 28 - Sally Ladsten

- Communication options in the greenhouse such as intercom and phone-currently rely on instructor cell phone and we are unable to hear school wide announcements, bells, and fire alarms
- Faucets on all sinks should extend far enough over the basin to prevent water from splashing back onto the counter (this happens almost every time a sink is used in room 58 and others)

March 3 - Mary Walz

- While co-curriculars need storage space, we could also use a multipurpose meeting room. A room that could sit at least 75. Have multiple locking storage closets around the room for storing materials needed for those items. For example NHS Shirts, Student Council decorations, Forensics props, Chess club boards, Art club paints, Class advisor fundraisers, or the Computer Science club robotics. This room could also be used by sports teams for impromptu meetings. Would be good to have sinks for cleaning materials.
- A computer classroom that can double as a computer science lab or computer science club meeting room.

March 3 - Mary Walz

- Is there a way to overhaul the faculty lunchroom so it is more inviting for more staff to gather for lunch?
- More staff bathrooms throughout the high school. Definitely on the south end.

March 4 - Troy Talford

- If possible to relocate electrical boxes right inside of room 59A (agriculture room and put a lower and upper cupboard in that would be very helpful with limited storage on the main level of the classroom.
- Have an indoor concessions stand that can serve as storage for concessions as well as the actual stand itself. Ideally this would be centrally located between the gyms.

March 5 - Jennifer Brennan

- Is there a way that we could incorporate more storage for a book room for the English and possibly other departments? This would be to hold class sets of novels, textbooks, LLI boxes, etc. so that a teacher can access it without interrupting classes in progress.
- Currently, the English classrooms have all different sorts of shelving for books. If we
 could have strong, but nice looking, shelving that would be great for classroom
 libraries/choice books.

- I would also love more breakout spaces for conferencing/workshopping to have some privacy for a student to share and also have eyes on the classroom.

- Adequate lighting for the work area. Current example is the Student Services office where the administrative assistants' work stations are. It is too dark, especially on days when there is no sunlight.

March 9 - John Dollar

- Looping back to Mary Walz's thoughts earlier, would it be possible to offer lockers to students only by request? If so, we could turn some of the existing lockers into new display cases for student work. I know we would make use of them here in the English / Art wing of the building. I would LOVE to have bulletin boards or open display cases in which to post student writing from creative writing classes, our newspaper unit in English 10b, etc.

March 9 - Mary Walz

- The two spruce trees located on the south side of the RAC where Spruce St intersects the HS were donated to the NHS by retired English teacher Mary Paddock in memory of her willing of the Mitten Tree to the NHS. Now known as the Giving Tree project. If they are to be moved, the NHS would like to have some input to the movement.

March 10th - Lorie Schara

- Family and Consumer Science Culinary Lab Space should have industry standard kitchens (including a 3 compartment sink, professional wash stations, hands free soap and paper dispensers, and ideally, home style kitchens as well.
