The amount each family pays for the after-school program is based on the family's income and size. Income* will be verified by the site lead and/or district coordinator. Once verified, the monthly family fee will be honored for the full year. The following are the sliding scale fees based on a family's gross monthly income for monthly, full-time participation for one child.

- **Full fees will be waived for students meeting the following eligibility criteria: McKinney Vento, foster youth, and/or free or reduced-price meal.**
- MUSD employee discount: 50% off the at cost monthly, full-time fee.
- Sibling discount: 10% off the family's qualifying tier monthly, full-time fee for each additional child
