

Maize South High School
Senior Painted Parking Spots Application

Please review the following rules and expectations, as well as the suggested tips, to help you prepare to paint your senior parking spot. These guidelines were created to ensure that we are highlighting Maverick pride while being able to celebrate this amazing senior rite of passage.

Rules & Expectations:

1. Each parking spot will cost \$60. Half of the cost will automatically be applied to future parking lot maintenance. The other half will be used to celebrate Maize South faculty and students.
2. All parking lot designs must be submitted with this application and approved by administration. Fee must be submitted with application.
3. Gold Card members will be able to sign up after school and choose their parking spot on Wednesday, September 3rd in the Commons. Other seniors will be able to sign up after school on Thursday, September 4th and Friday, September 5th.
4. Gold Card students will have the chance to choose their parking spots first. The remaining parking spots will be sold on a first come first serve basis.
5. Students must provide their own brushes, paint, tape, etc. **Water based exterior paint** is recommended.
 - No spray paint
 - No oil based paint
 - No glitter
 - No clearcoat
6. Students must leave a 4 inch space between their design and the parking lines. Students can not paint on the parking lines or parking spot numbers.
7. Designs must be school appropriate. The following are prohibited:
 - No offensive pictures, flags, or symbols
 - No innuendos, negative, offensive, or demoralizing language
 - No reference to drugs or drug use
 - No reference to firearms or the use of them

Suggested Tips

1. Use a broom to sweep away any debris.
2. Chalk is great to use to sketch your design before you paint.
3. Bring both paint brushes *and* paint rollers, as well as paint pans or plastic containers for water. Painter's tape is also suggested for nice clean lines.
4. A drop cloth to place under the paint cans is advised.
5. Bring a towel to sit or kneel on and friends to help you paint.

We will block off the East parking lot on September 20th and 21st from 8 am - 8 pm for students and families to paint their spots. You will be allowed to paint your spot at a later time if you are unable to attend the painting party on the 20th or 21st. You *cannot* paint your spot earlier.

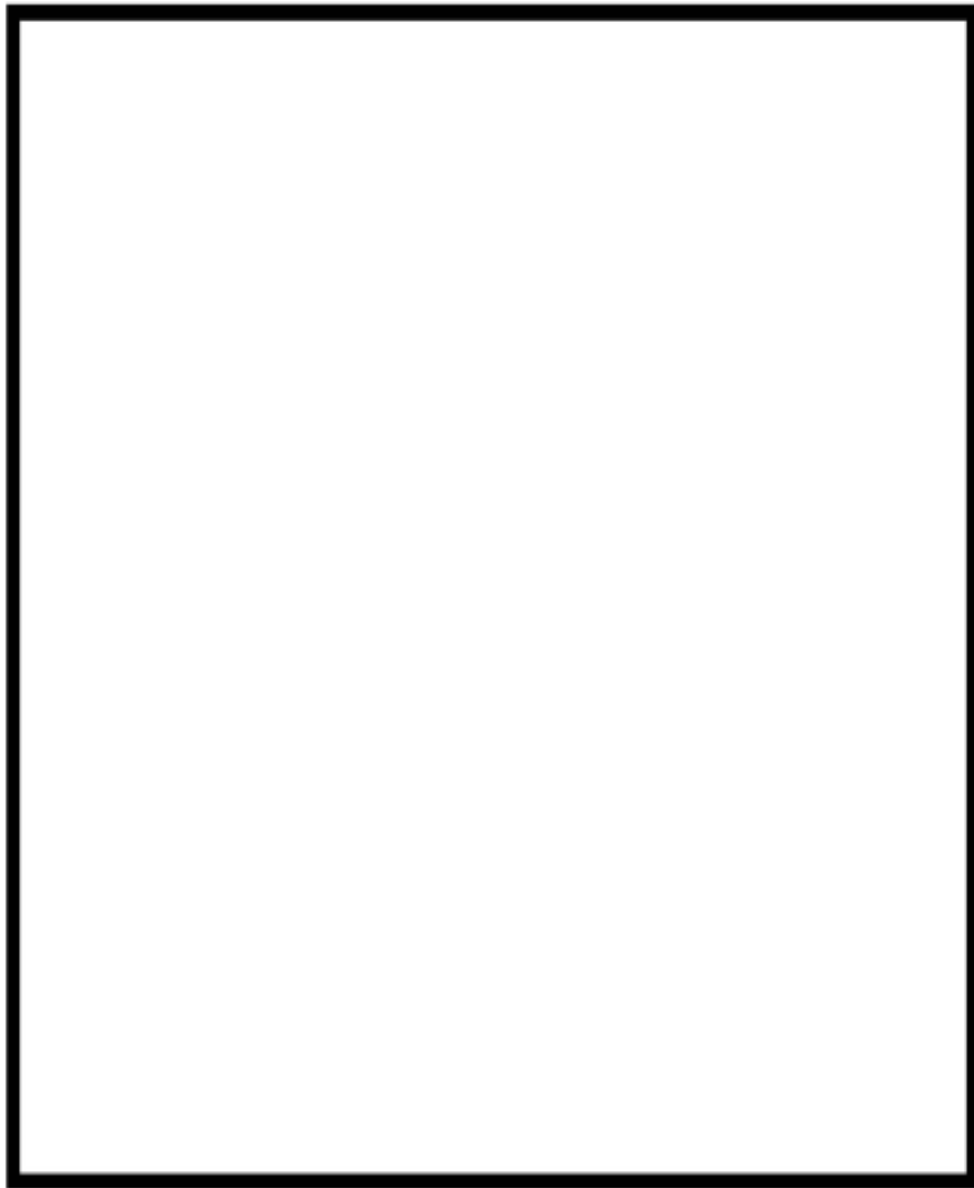
